ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION PLAN

The administrative organization of the school district is the responsibility of the Superintendent. They shall devise a district organizational plan which shall be approved by the Board of Education. The legal authority of the Board is transmitted through the Superintendent along specific paths from person to person as shown in the organizational chart that they will annually create.

The Superintendent may recognize lines of authority and revise the organizational chart subject to Board approval of the elimination and creation of positions. The Board expects the Superintendent to keep the administrative structure up to date with the needs for supervision and accountability throughout the school system.
