Purpose

Students' attire significantly influences the learning environment of any school. The purpose of SVA's



Uniform Policy is to promote school unity and pride, lessen peer pressure, and minimize the distractions and disruptions that some clothing may attract while establishing habits of neatness, good grooming, modesty, and cleanliness. All students are expected to dress appropriately while on school premises or at any school-sponsored activity. Enrollment in SVA constitutes acceptance of this Policy, agreement to adhere to it, and acknowledgment of discipline for noncompliance.

Overview

- Polo shirts and bottoms/jumpers (except those noted) may be purchased from any vendor who carries a *specific Uniform line*.
- Students may wear non-logoed, plain navy, white, gray, or black sweaters in the classroom.
- All bottoms that are not pants (shorts, skirts, skorts, scooters, shorts, and jumpers) must be no more than two (2) inches above the knee.
- All tops and solid-color jumpers must have the SVA logo embroidered by an approved vendor (see below).
- Shorts are allowed all year.
- Students may wear SkyView Academy jackets, fleece, and hoodies in the classroom.
- All shirts must be tucked in.
- Hats are allowed to be worn during recess only and must be removed when in the school building.
- If a Uniform item is not listed below, it may not be worn.
- Any Uniform issues not addressed in this policy will be resolved at the discretion of the Administration.

Required Uniform Items

Boys

- Khaki pants (pleated or flat front only)
- Navy long or short sleeve polo

Girls

- Khaki bottom (pants, skirt, skort, scooter, jumper)
- Navy long or short sleeve polo shirt

Boys

- Navy pants/shorts (pleated or flat front only)
- Maize long or short sleeve Polo shirt (from Lands' End only)
- Forest green long or short sleeve Polo shirt

Girls

- Navy pants or shorts (pleated or flat front only)
- Navy skirt, skort or scooter Forest green long or short sleeve Polo shirt
- Maize long or short sleeve Polo shirt (from Lands' End only) Forest green long or short sleeve Polo shirt

Formal Uniform

Formal Uniform Day is the **first Wednesday** of every month. The purpose of Formal Uniform Day is to establish an understanding that there are times when more formal attire is appropriate. Other days throughout the school year may be designated a Formal Uniform Day as determined by the Administration. Students and families will be notified ahead of time.

Boys

Formal Uniform Options:

- White **Button Up with** SVA Approved Embroidered logo any style short/long sleeved)
- Khaki pants or shorts
- **Optional:** Plaid 9A Bow Tie/Tie **AND** Navy

Girls

Formal Uniform Options:

- White **Button Up with** logo (any style short/long sleeved)
- Khaki pants, skort, short **OR**
- 9A SkyView Plaid skirt **OR**
- SkyView Plaid Jumper and a **Navy** or White Long or Short Sleeve Shirt
- **Optional:** Plaid 9A Bow

Cardigan sweater
without a logo.

- Additional options for our 8th-grade students: They may join the High School and wear Interview Attire for their formal wear day.

- ADDITIONAL OPTION for our 8th Grade Students: They may join the High School and wear Interview Attire for their formal wear day.

Socks (Boys and Girls) and Knee Highs/Tights/Leggings (Girls only)

- Students of all grade levels must wear socks, knee-highs, or tights.
 - Socks must be solid in color and without patterns.
 - Colors must match well with the uniform.
- Students may wear leggings under skirts and jumpers. They must be a solid color and coordinate with the uniform.
- *The Principal has final discretionary judgment on whether color choices are appropriate.*

Shoes

Shoes must complement the uniform and have no distracting features, such as blinking lights. For safety reasons no wheelies, no sandals/flip flops, no Crocs, or other similar shoes. No characters or light-up shoes. Athletic shoes must be worn during P.E. (see class schedule for details). Boots are only allowed during inclement weather or when snow is present.

Belts

A navy, black, brown, or 9A SkyView Plaid belt (9A SkyView Plaid must be purchased from Educational Outfitters or the SVA School Store) must be worn at all times by students in grades 1st – 8th with any item that has belt loops. Belts must have modestly sized buckles and may not have any “bling,” characters, or otherwise distracting elements.

Student Grooming

Good grooming and etiquette can help students present a polished image, boost confidence, and improve their overall self-confidence. Here are some tips for students on grooming and etiquette:

- Maintain a consistent hygiene routine, including daily showers, brushing teeth, washing



hands, and using deodorant.

- Keep hair neat and well-groomed, and out of your face during class.
- Keep nails clean and trimmed, and avoid painting them in vivid colors.

Spirit Wear Friday

SkyView students may wear Khaki uniform bottoms and SkyView Spirit wear of their choice each Friday. Examples of SkyView Spirit wear include, but are not limited to, SVA Wish Week Shirts, SVA Choir Shirts, Marathon Challenge T-shirts, SVA Fun Run T-shirts, and MS PE T-shirts.

Items Not Allowed

- Bottoms cannot be cargo or corduroy or have extra pockets or stitching.
- Shoes: No wheelies, no sandals/flip flops, no Crocs, or other similar shoes. No characters or light-up shoes.
- Belt loops may not be removed.
- Shirts may not have any extra ribbing, stitching, or decoration.
- Socks, tights, or knee-highs may not have any extra colors, designs, or patterns (cable pattern allowed).
- Jackets, fleece, and hoodies lacking the SkyView Academy logo may be worn to school but must be removed once in the classroom.
- Patches are prohibited on any Uniform items (e.g., may not patch torn pant knees).

Field Trip Uniform

For both boys and girls, the SVA Field Trip Uniform consists of khaki bottoms with a white long or short-sleeved polo shirt. All students attending field trips must wear their SVA Field Trip Uniform unless otherwise directed by the SVA Administration.

Spirit Wear on Fridays

Each Friday, PS and ES students may wear SkyView spirit wear (tops with SkyView logos/events printed on them) and uniform bottoms.

Dress of Choice Day (DOC)

Dress of Choice Day is given on the **first Friday** of each month. DOC demonstrates that there are



times when more casual wear is appropriate. Students can participate in DOC if they participate in Formal Uniform Day on the first Wednesday of the month. Open-toed, wheeled, or any other footwear that compromises safety, as determined by the administration, will not be allowed. Certain clothing items, for example, tank tops, pajamas, and shirts with inappropriate language or messages, will not be permitted. All clothing should meet length requirements and be in good repair, as this policy outlines.

Extreme Styles

- Fashion Forward extremes that distract the learning environment or create an environment that isolates students do not comply with the purpose of the dress code and should not be worn during the school day.
- Items of clothing that fit a given environment, such as a fitness center or a club environment, are inappropriate for the learning environment and should not be worn during the school day.
- Items of clothing in extreme disrepair, whether for a fashion statement or otherwise, are inappropriate for the learning environment and should not be worn during the school day.
- Shorts and leggings must extend beyond the length of a shirt, blouse, or sweatshirt without consistently pulling the shorts or leggings down.

Exceptions

Organizational Uniforms such as Boy Scout and Girl Scout Uniforms may be worn in place of, or in addition to, the SVA Student Uniform. If the Organizational Uniform does not include all clothing elements as required above (e.g., no specified Organizational Uniform pants/skirt), the applicable SVA Uniform component should be worn with the Organizational Uniform components.

Temporary exceptions to the clothing requirements of this policy may be granted by the Administration for hardship, as an individual reward, or as part of Dress of Choice Day. Exceptions to the clothing requirements of this policy shall not include exceptions to the student grooming standards set forth herein unless expressly authorized by the Administration. Upon request, reasonable accommodations in the Uniform Policy shall be made by the Administration for students with disabilities or religious convictions that conflict with the code.
