Getting to the Upper School

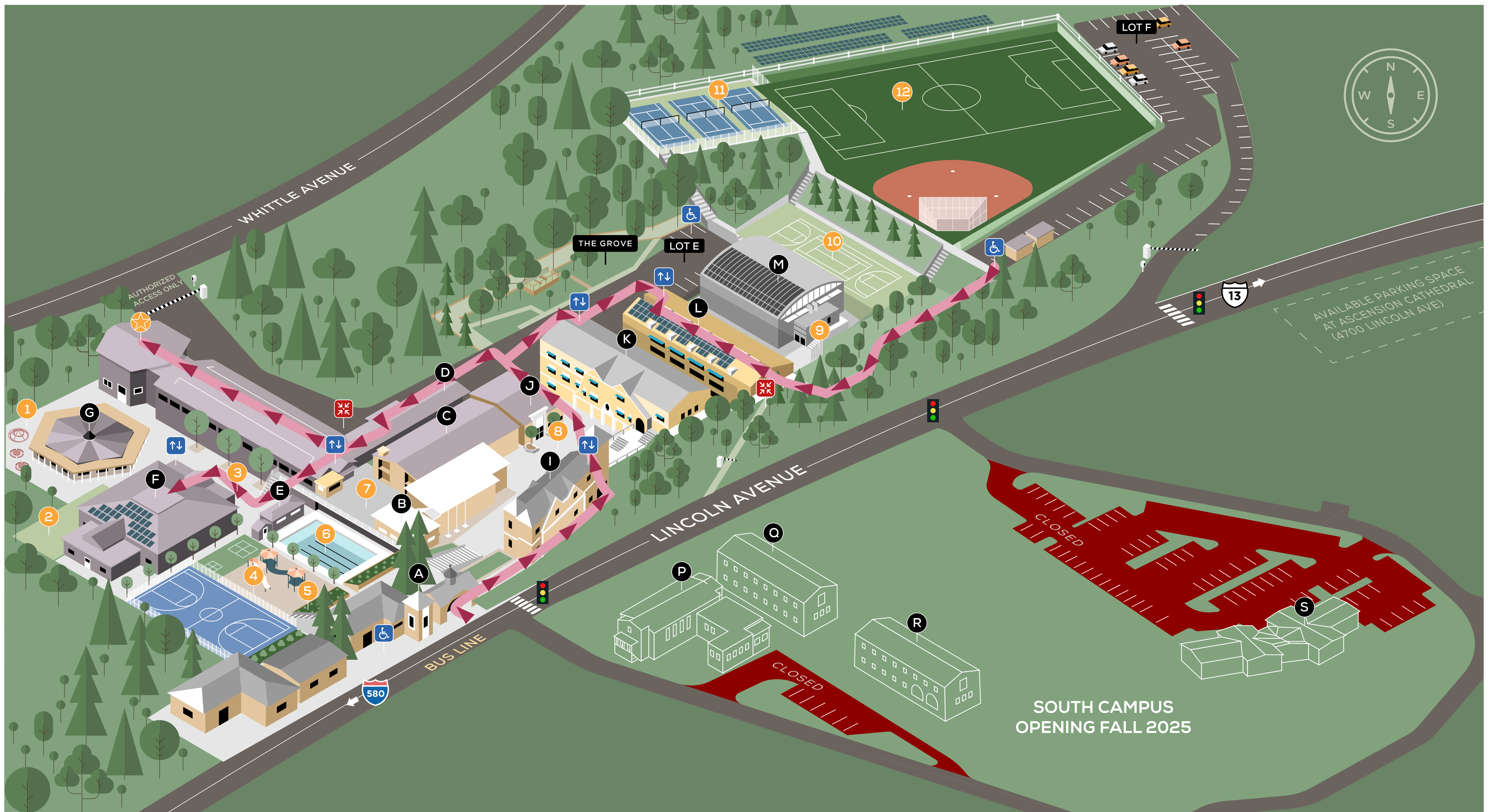
1. Enter through the Main Entrance
2. Continue down the ramp to the right
3. At the bottom of the ramp, there will be an elevator on your left
4. Go to Level 1
5. Exit the elevator and turn right towards the Upper School Patio
6. Follow the path that curves left
7. Turn right on the sidewalk
8. Enter through the double doors to your right marked with an elevator sign
9. Take the elevator to the desired floor inside the Main Upper School Building (Building K)
10. To continue to the Upper School Pavilion Building (Building L) or Gym (Building M), take the elevator to Level BR
11. Exit the building
12. Another elevator will be right in front of you to access Level 2 of the Upper School Pavilion Building if needed

Getting to the Middle School

1. Follow steps 1–6 above
2. Go straight to take the paved driveway
3. At the end of the driveway, turn left and enter the Middle School Building through the double doors
4. Turn right
5. To continue to the Middle School Level 1, turn right again at the end of the hallway
6. The elevator will be to your right

Getting to the Lower School

1. Follow steps 1–6 above
2. Take the elevator to Level 1
3. Exit and turn left
4. At the end of the hallway, turn right
5. Exit the double doors towards the Lower School Patio
6. To continue to the Lower School 2–5 Building (Building F), cross the patio
7. Take the ramp
8. Enter through the green double doors and turn right
9. The elevator will be at the end of the small hallway
