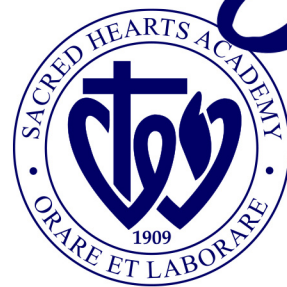

Through this journey – tailored just for the ELC students – **boys and girls ages three to five** will grow their knowledge and build key foundational skills in reading, mathematics, science and more.

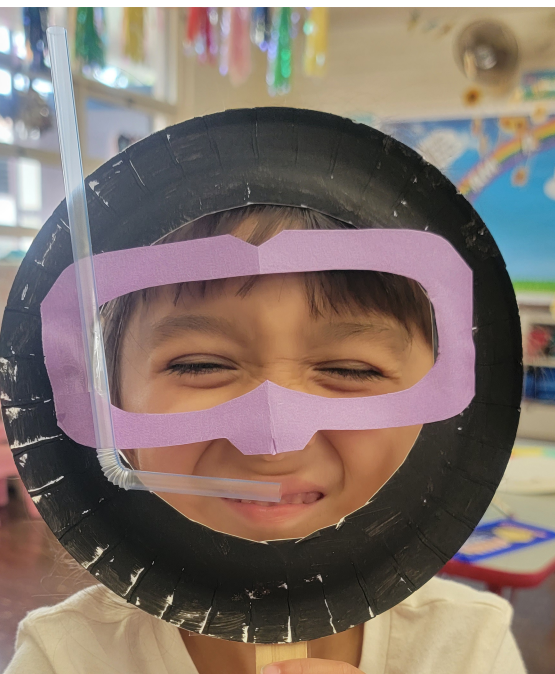
A myriad of summer treats and fun experiences are also on the fascinating agenda.

HOW TO REGISTER (ONLINE) + FORMS AND MATERIALS

The **SUMMER PROGRAM GUIDE** for the **EARLY LEARNING CENTER** with course descriptions and details are available at the **ACADEMY'S** website (www.sacredhearts.org).

TUITION

A refund, minus a \$50 registration fee may be obtained if a student withdraws prior to April 15.

A refund minus a \$100 fee will be given if a student withdraws from April 15 to May 31. Fifty percent of tuition paid will be refunded if a student withdraws from June 1 to 7.

No refunds will be given after June 7.

SUMMER CAFETERIA + MEAL DETAILS

Mealtime accounts can be used to purchase breakfast and snacks. These accounts can be purchased after registration is complete and students receive identification credentials.

Six-week meal plans to pay for hot lunches only are available for purchase.

Offerings meet USDA nutrition guidelines. These must be purchased before June 9.

SNACKS + LUNCH

Students may bring lunch and snacks from home, or these may be ordered from Sodexo, the school's food service provider. Individually pre-packaged lunch or snack orders will be delivered to the student's classroom.

Students are encouraged to bring their own water bottles and must never share drinks, utensils or food.

Refills for water bottles will be done by their teachers and staff as needed.

ADDITIONAL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Students currently enrolled and attending **PRESCHOOL** and **KINDERGARTEN** in Hawai'i and the continental United States do not

need to submit health examination requirements to attend **SUMMER PROGRAMS** at the **ACADEMY**.

However, **INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS** currently attending school in a country outside of the United States are required to submit additional documents before attending the **ACADEMY'S SUMMER PROGRAMS**.

These three required documents should detail:

- ▶ A complete physical
- ▶ Current TB test result from an evaluation conducted in the United States
- ▶ Immunization records (only reports from the country of origin detailing immunization information will be accepted).

These documents must be in English or have an English translation.

TB test results, a health physical report and immunization records for international students should be mailed or submitted online*#.

CONDUCT STANDARDS

Students at the **ACADEMY** are expected to uphold the following standards:

- ▶ Be respectful and kind in their relations with others at all times and be respectful of authority.

ATTIRE + DRESS STANDARDS

Students not adhering to the dress code for the **EARLY LEARNING CENTER (ELC)** will be sent home and required to change.

Swimwear tank tops and bare midriffs are not acceptable at any time.

In addition to the items above, bare midriffs, tees with inappropriate language or designs and extra-short shorts are also not acceptable.

EARLY LEARNING CENTER (ELC)

PROCEDURES FOR DROP-OFF + CHECK-IN

Students attending the **ACADEMY'S SUMMER PROGRAMS** must be checked-in by authorized adults.

Students can be dropped-off at the **ELC** facility starting at 7 a.m.

Authorized adults completing check-in and drop-off procedures can park in designated stalls in the parking lot fronting Waialae Avenue.

PROCEDURES FOR PICK-UP + CHECK-OUT

ELC students attending only the **DAY SESSION** should be checked-out by authorized adults and picked-up at the Autoline along 5th Avenue - enter from Waialae Avenue - beginning at 11:45 a.m..

Those attending the **DAY SESSION** and **EXTENDED SUMMER** care should be checked-out and picked-up at the **ELC** facility by 5:30 p.m.
