FIT Georgia

As part of your child's P.E. program, Barnwell is preparing to take part in the FIT Georgia physical fitness assessment. All students in 1st through 5th grades will participate in this assessment, which aligns with the state law requiring schools to measure areas of fitness related to the health of students, including cardiovascular endurance, muscular strength and endurance, flexibility, and body composition. After the assessment, you will receive a student report that includes a brief explanation of each fitness assessment, details on the importance of each assessment, and your child's actual scores. Traffic, Bus Lane, and Carpool Safety
