CHECK IN - CHECK OUT

When it is necessary for a student to leave campus for an appointment or illness, the student must pick up an off campus pass in the Front Office using the RAPTOR system.

1. If leaving for an appointment, student brings a note to the main office and will be directed to use the RAPTOR system to generate an Off-Campus Pass. If a student does not bring a note, a parent may call.
2. If the student returns to school after the appointment, he/she needs to check in at the front office through RAPTOR with a note signed by a parent, doctor or dentist to clear the absence.
3. If the student is not returning to school after the appointment, or because they are ill, the parent/guardian will need to indicate this when taking the student and the student will be cleared for the rest of the day.
