CAMPUS REMINDERS

Loss of Privileges/Non-Privilege list – If someone abuses a previously earned privilege, that privilege can be revoked. The student can earn it back by successfully engaging in the expected behavior under supervision, or by meeting prearranged criteria for reinstatement of the privilege. Loss of certain campus privileges (dances, sports, extra-curricular events, etc) might be applied in response to any behavioral incident for a predetermined length of time. The Non-Privilege list will be enforced this week during all extra-curricular activities.

To be eligible to participate in extra and co-curricular events you must have a 2.0 GPA, 85% attendance or better, and good behavior. Eligibility is determined every week for participation the following week. Questions? See Ms. Toback
