Kindergarten registration for Fall 2025 opens February 3, 2025 at:
www.fargo.k12.nd.us/registration

Child must be age 5 by July 31, 2025 to attend school in the fall.

Registration is a two-step process:

STEP 1: Register Online

Complete online registration forms at **www.fargo.k12.nd.us/registration**.

STEP 2: Submit Documentation

Upload or bring the following documents to your child's school to finalize registration:

- ☐ Child's certified birth certificate
- ☐ Child's immunization record, with 5-year shots
- ☐ Two documents that include parent/guardian name and current address (e.g. utility bill and paystub)

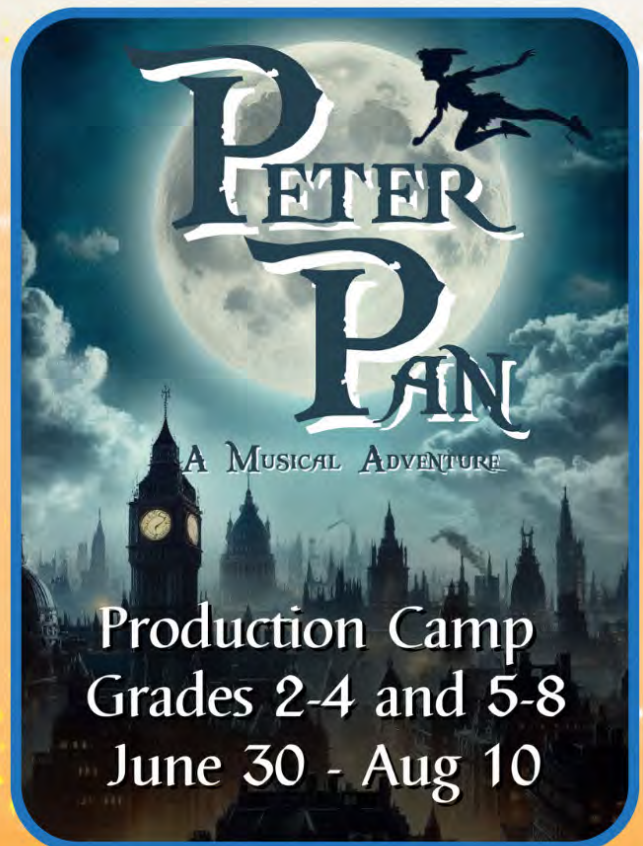
