A work permit is a legal document required by the state of California that allows a person under 18 years of age to hold a job. You may get a work permit from our high school office. Work permits must be renewed each school year.

There are four steps in obtaining a work permit:

1. Obtain a job
2. Obtain a work permit application at ULHS
3. Bring signed work permit application to ULHS and work permit will be issued
4. Maintain positive attendance and grades
