In the United States, there are 574 federally recognized Native American tribes, plus an estimated 400 more that are unrecognized, that speak nearly 200 different indigenous languages, making for an incredible diversity in culture and way of life. Unfortunately, Native American representation in popular culture has long been saddled with offensive stereotypes, caricatures, and mascots. Depictions of Native American life and culture often homogenize and flatten it — if it is represented at all. But despite this lack of fair recognition, famous Native Americans continue to break barriers in science, politics, cooking, sports, and more, including excelling as business owners and authors.
