Complete the form to apply for financial aid for college, career school, or graduate school.</p> <p><b>Who should complete the FAFSA® form?</b> Any student, regardless of income, who wants to be considered for federal, state, and school financial aid programs. This includes grants, scholarships, work-study funds, and loans.</p> <p><b>How long will it take?</b> It takes most people less than one hour to fill out the FAFSA form, including gathering any personal documents and financial information needed to complete it.</p> <p><b>What do I need?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Verified account username and password (FSA ID)</li><li>• Parent or spouse contributor name, date of birth, Social Security number, and email address</li><li>• Income and asset information (if required)</li></ul>
