Early Elementary Proficiency



Positive Growth



- Compared to the 2022-2023 baseline, kindergarten proficiency increased by 3%.
- First grade proficiency increased by 4%.
- Total proficiency rates for Spring 2024:
 - Kindergarten: 65%
 - First Grade: 50%
- Kindergarten students with disabilities saw a 5% increase in proficiency.
- This aligns with Red Clay's focus on equitable outcomes for all student subgroups.

Advancing College & Career Readiness



Success in Secondary School Programming



- Red Clay's Strategic Plan focuses on equitable college and career programming for all secondary students.
- Key Performance Indicator: Increase in High School Students participating in College Level Coursework (AP, Dual-Enrollment, IB).
- 15% increase in total seat count for college-level coursework (2482 to 2858).
- 13% increase in students taking at least one college-level course (1005 to 1140).

- Early College Academy partnerships with Goldey-Beacom College at Alexis I duPont and Thomas McKean High Schools.
- Expansion of AP Seminar access for all 10th-grade students.

- Expansion of Pre-AP programming for equitable access to college-level c
