

Parents as Partners

Parents and students should be committed to the program as it progresses each year. Second language proficiency typically takes at least 5-7 years to develop.

Parents can support language learning at home by fostering an environment that encourages bilingual development. This includes promoting regular use of both languages in daily conversations, reading together each day to build literacy skills, actively participating in school and community events that celebrate language and culture, and nurturing a positive attitude toward bilingualism by recognizing its benefits and celebrating progress.
