The Preliminary SAT (PSAT) is a mode for high school sophomores and juniors to achieve their college goals. It measures reading, writing, language, and math skills. After the test, students receive feedback on college readiness along with tools for improvement. Advantages of taking the PSAT include:

- Personalized online practice tailored to the student's strengths and weaknesses.
- An interactive score report with answer explanations for SAT practice questions and full-length tests
- Detailed feedback on the student's progress
- Detailed personality test to assist in finding majors and careers that fit the student's talents and interests
- Tools for exploring colleges, majors, and scholarships
- Eligibility for junior students in the Nation Merit Scholarship Program

The PSAT will be offered at Sabine High School on Thursday October 10th at 8:00 am in the auditorium. Students may sign up and pay the \$18 fee in the high school office with test supplies last. There will be no exam makeup day. Homeschool students may sign up while supplies last.
