PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



Aloha HBA friends and family,

Reflecting on the 2023-2024 school year, I am filled with gratitude for God's abundant blessings on our HBA community. This year marked the beginning of our journey toward reimagining our learning environment with the launch of the "Campaign for Transformation," inspiring our theme,

"Dig In," which is rooted in 1 Corinthians 15:58 (NLT):

So, my dear brothers and sisters, be strong and immovable. Always work enthusiastically for the Lord, for you know that nothing you do for the Lord is ever useless.

Embracing this call to stay focused and committed, we celebrated the following outstanding accomplishments:

- **The Class of 2024:** Among our 80 graduates, I am pleased that all of these graduates have been accepted to colleges in Hawai'i, on the mainland and abroad! There were 19 students recognized as Sons and Daughters of HBA, having attended since kindergarten, while 7 were acknowledged as Legacy Graduates. We had 31 students graduating with highest honors and 21 with honors, embodying the academic excellence we strive for.
- **Student Films at the Hawai'i International Film Festival:** Our film program had two films selected for the 'Ōpio Fest. *Different*, directed by James Kaneshige ('26) and starring Nainoa Nakamura ('24), and *Fight Screen*, directed by Andrew Lohr ('26) and Eugene Caruso ('23), were showcased among other student films statewide. *Fight Screen* received the Best Visual Effects award, and *Different* was featured at the HBA Arts & Film Festival that happened on May 3, 2024.
- **Scholastic Art Awards Recognition:** Nineteen HBA students were honored at the 2024 Hawai'i Regional Scholastic Art Awards, showcasing their talents across various mediums including oil pastels, ink drawings, and mixed media. Mina Kwon and Lexie Kadooka earned prestigious Gold Key Awards. Their artwork was displayed at Capitol Modern in March.
- **Math Team's State Championship Victory:** The HBA Mathematics Team clinched its first Oahu Mathematics League (OML) Newton Division championship on April 20. Led by Jaden Oki ('25), who scored highest in the final meet, the team persevered through a competitive season to secure this historic win and brought home the perpetual trophy.
- **Eagle Eye Journalism Awards:** Our journalism team was recognized at the 2024 Hawai'i High School Journalism Awards with five category awards, including Best Website. Their dedication also earned them third place in the overall Best-in-State competition.

- **HMSA Kaimana Award for School Excellence:** HBA received its seventh HMSA Kaimana Award in the past eight years, representing the Interscholastic League of Honolulu (ILH). HBA remains the only ILH school to be recognized all 19 years of the program, a testament to our consistent excellence in academics, athletics, and community service.
- **Athletic Achievements:** Our students demonstrated sportsmanship and skill, with varsity teams winning ILH Division 2 titles in girls and boys tennis, and boys bowling. HBA athletes also contributed to Pac-Five's championships in girls and boys soccer and softball. Notably, our boys' bowling team captured the state championship, marking the program's sixth overall title under Coach Greg Hayashi's leadership.
- **Community Service Initiatives:** Our students embodied the spirit of service, participating in numerous outreach projects led by grade-level advisors, the Honor Society, and the Interact Club. They contributed to organizations such as the American Cancer Society, Special Olympics, Kuakini Adult Rehabilitation, and the Ronald McDonald House.

We rejoice in the spiritual growth within our HBA community this year, as 40 students for the Elementary Campus and over 42 students from our Middle School and High School camps accepted Jesus into their lives for the first time. These moments of faith affirm our commitment to nurturing not just academic and personal excellence, but spiritual growth as well.

The year concluded with a significant milestone on May 9, 2024, when we broke ground for the new facilities at the Richard Bento Elementary Campus, symbolizing the start of a transformative era at HBA ahead of our 75th Anniversary.

As 1 Corinthians 15:58 reminds us, our achievements are made meaningful through the dedication of our students, faculty, and staff, as well as the unwavering support of our donors, alumni, and the wider community. Your prayers and partnership have empowered us to continue pursuing our motto: Christ for Every Nation.

In its 75th year as one of Hawai'i's top college preparatory schools, Hawai'i Baptist Academy celebrated a major milestone on May 9, 2024, with a ceremonial groundbreaking for new facilities at its Richard Bento Elementary Campus.

THIS INITIATIVE is part of a multi-year capital campaign that will also fund an endowment for an expanded programmatic curriculum, extending the school's impact to parents and the broader community.

"Today marks a significant milestone in our school's journey—one that signifies growth, progress, and the realization of our collective vision," remarked HBA President, Ron Shiira '75.

"This project represents more than just a physical transformation of our elementary campus; it symbolizes our unwavering commitment to transforming the lives of students through faith, innovation, and leadership."

The new facilities will include state-of-the-art spaces equipped with the latest technology, fostering dynamic learning environments. Highlights include the 7,000 square-foot Innovation and Discovery Center, rooftop deck, outdoor amphitheater, multi-use covered playcourt, renovated campus entryway, and resurfaced campus lower courts. These designs are crafted by Honolulu-based architect G70.

"Looking forward, we are excited about this new era for HBA and our community," said elementary school principal Dr. Emmett Winters.

Constructed by Allied Builders Systems, all phases of the expansion project are expected to be completed in the summer of 2026.

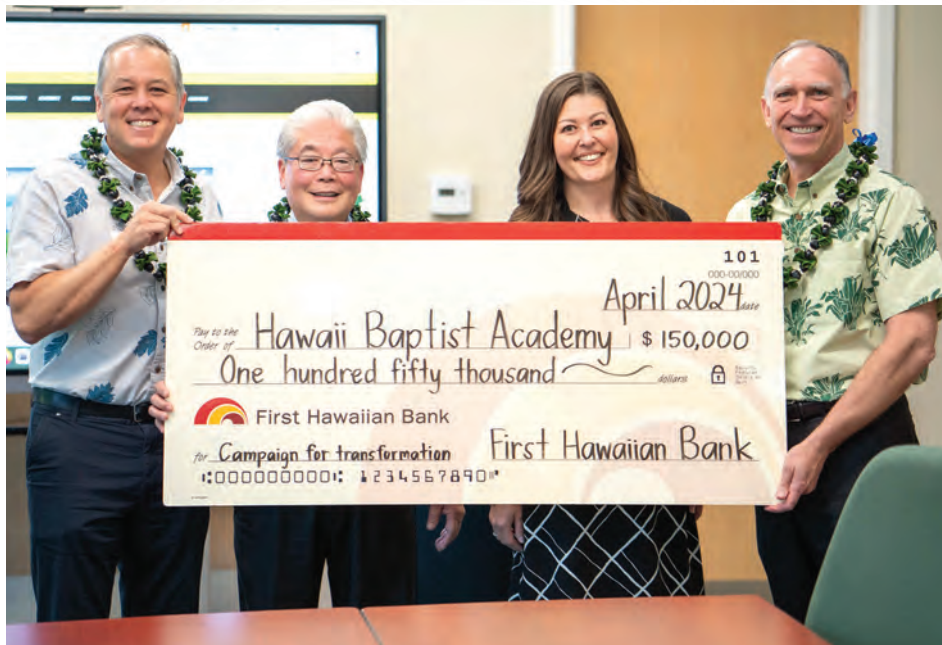

A HEART FOR TEACHING:

How Hawai'i Baptist Academy Shaped Terence Li's Life and Mission



For **Terence Li '02**, being an educator is far more than a career—it's a calling shaped by the transformative experiences and deep mentorship he received at Hawai'i Baptist Academy (HBA). Today, as an alumnus and teacher at his alma mater, Terence draws from his own journey to inspire and guide his students, ensuring that the legacy of HBA continues to touch lives for generations to come.

A Safe Haven and the Seeds of Faith

As a student, Terence often stayed on campus long after the school day ended, a tradition common for his generation of HBA students. "That's what made it feel like home," he recalls. Faculty like George Honzaki would remain after hours to support students, whether through academic help or spiritual guidance.

Coming from a non-Christian household, Terence was profoundly impacted by this openness. "I became a teacher because of George when I was in 8th grade," he shares. "He was very welcoming and offered his room as a place for us to hang out." Honzaki also introduced Terence to Youth for Christ (YFC) activities, becoming both a father figure and a Christian mentor.

It was during his first year at HBA, at Christian Emphasis Week (CEW), that Terence embraced faith in Christ. "They asked me if I would like to receive everlasting life, and my hand went up. My 5th grade teacher, Iris Uehara, prayed for me and out of that prayer, my faith took root."

Faculty: A Living Example of Faith

Terence credits HBA's faculty as the bedrock of his spiritual and professional growth. "The amazing thing about HBA faculty is how much of their time they serve—not only to HBA but also to their churches and God," he says. This selflessness creates a culture where teachers lead by example, encouraging students to think deeply about faith, morality, and their place in the world.

"Bible classes challenged us to think about our place in the world and how our faith is relevant to it," he reflects. "Teachers live out their faith, and that's what I've been a beneficiary of through people like Mrs. Uehara and others."

Teaching as an Alumnus

Now in the classroom himself, Terence finds joy in connecting with his students and helping them prepare for their futures. Having walked the same halls and studied under many of the same teachers, he relates to their experiences. "I want them to feel proud of their education, which means I have to be a good teacher too," he explains.

His passion for teaching stems from the indescribable reward of witnessing a student's "aha" moment when a challenging concept clicks. "Teaching is a lot of delayed gratification," he says. "All teachers throughout a student's life contribute to that one moment of success. It's about the student's path."

ABOUT THE HILDA SHIRAKI MEMORIAL FOUNDATION

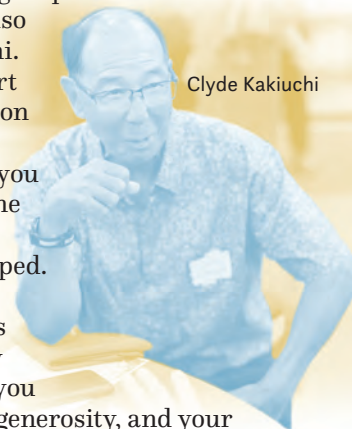
MRS. HILDA KIKUNO SHIRAKI, (born Kikue Yoshida), 1903–1997. She was a daughter of Naohiko and Ichi Yoshida, natives of Kumamoto, Japan. Hilda was born in Kaumana, Hilo, Hawai'i Island. In 1939 Hilda married George M. Shiraki (1906–1959), proprietor of George's Delicatessen. George and Hilda operated two delis in downtown Honolulu. They sold both restaurants in May 1958 to Yoshio and Kiyomi Ueda of Ueda Enterprises. Hilda was a member of Olivet Baptist Church. While at this church she met Stanley Kiyoshi Togikawa. Together with the help of Olivet's pastor, the Rev. Dan Kong, they established the Shiraki Memorial Foundation. This foundation has provided financial support to over a thousand students locally in Hawai'i, on the U.S. Mainland, and Christian ministries worldwide.

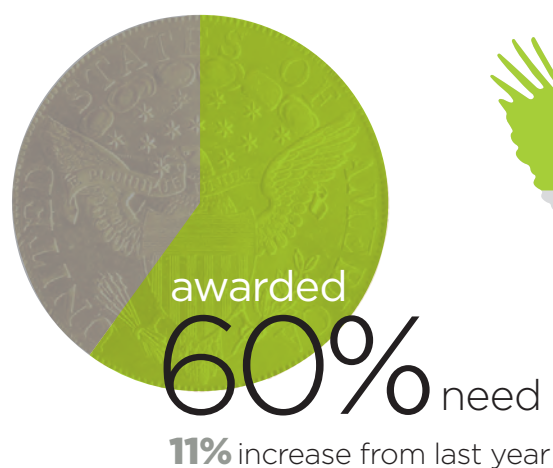

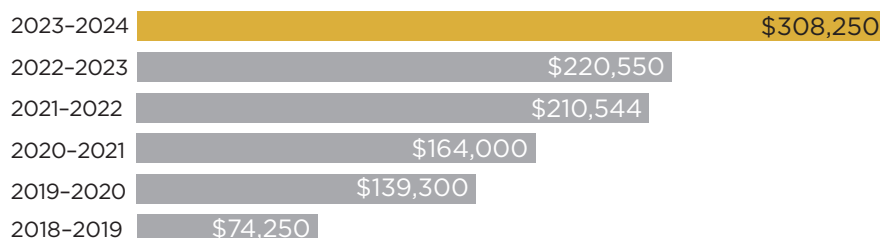

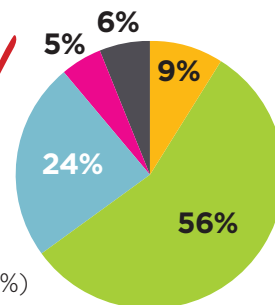
