### Taylor competes in Rubik's Cube competitions

SHES 5th grader Jackson Taylor is an avid Rubik's Cuber. This past fall, he was in his first competition - the Great Lakes WCA Speedcubing Competition in Louisville. Then in January, he went to Vanderbilt University for the Vanderbilt Winter 2025 speedcubing competition.

Jackson's fastest time on a 3x3 Rubik's Cube was 19.21 seconds and 5.10 seconds on a 2x2 cube. Jackson's next competition will occur in May at Northern Kentucky University.
