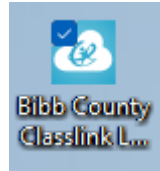



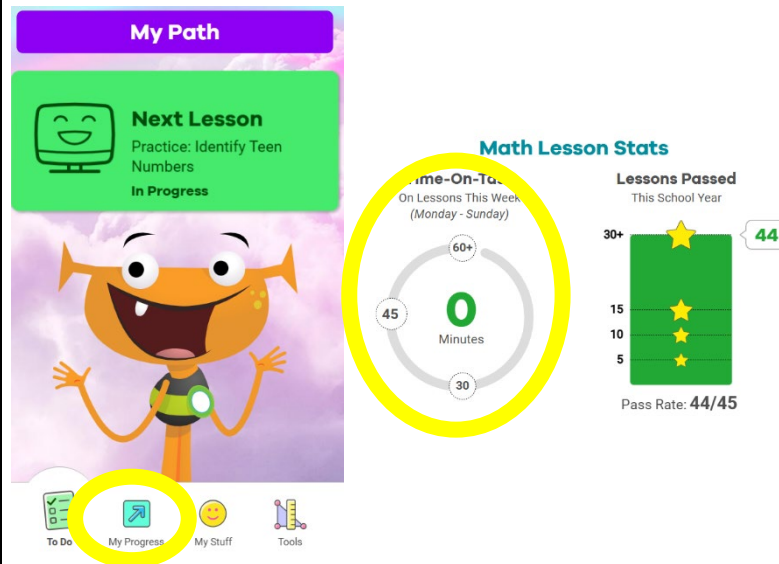

Personalized pathway and learning plan to provide targeted instruction in the areas where students need the most support. When students login, they simply click “My Path”.

GOAL: 45 minutes a week completed in about 3 15-minute sessions. The key is frequent, distributed practice!

TIP: You can view your students weekly time and progress by having your student login and clicking on the progress tab. If your student shows 0 minutes for Time-On-Task, then they likely need to try to get a few 15-minute sessions completed.

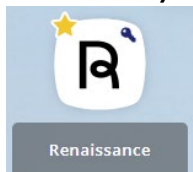

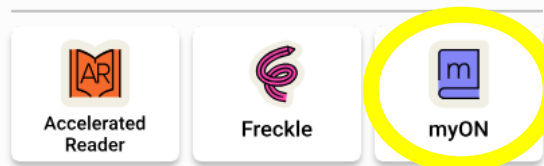
E-books,

Student-centered personalized digital library that gives access to over 7000 enhanced digital books

GOAL: 15-30 minutes of reading daily either with print books OR digital materials like the ones found in MyOn or SORA

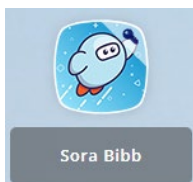
TIP: When MyOn launches, the dashboard will show you your Child’s Star Score, Reading Range (ATOS ZPD) and Lexile. You can search for books that fall within their Lexile to make sure they are reading books that support their needs!



Check out the Lexile stretch bands for each grade level. The goal is to have each student within their grade level band. If you do not know your child’s Lexile, ask them to login to Renaissance, click on MyOn and check out the dashboard to see their Lexile. You can also sign up to get emailed reports of your child’s progress (AR, STAR).

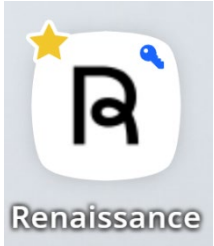
Digital reading platform that gives K12 students access to e-books, audiobooks, and other reading material

GOAL: 15-30 minutes of reading daily either with print books OR digital materials like the ones found in MyOn or SORA

TIP: Students have all access to Decodables and Magazines. If students find a book that is not all access, they need to choose the “borrow” option. If all copies are checked out, they will be prompted to “Place Hold”. Students can borrow three resources at a time.

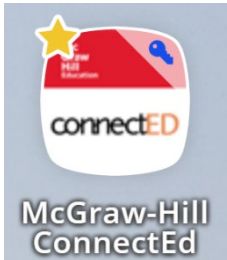

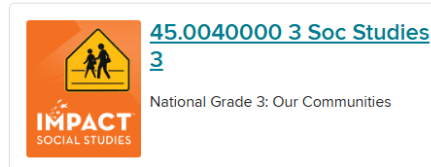

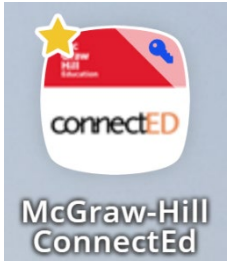
Social Studies
