<p><b>UPDATE -Driving Safely on Campus and Traffic Protocols</b></p>	<p>The <b>safety of our students and staff</b> on our campus is paramount, including the assurance that bus and emergency vehicles can always enter/exit the school property.</p> <p>We have noticed an increase in drivers who are not following traffic laws and protocols. We actively collaborate with the Trumbull Police Department and would like to remind drivers on our campus of the following: <b>Vehicles cannot block any crosswalks or fire lanes, or park in “No Parking” zones. Vehicles cannot pass a school bus displaying flashing red lights. Violations could result in ticketing administered by the Trumbull Police Department.</b></p> <p><b>Drop off</b> areas are at the rear of the building using parking lot 4 and football field side ONLY, not in the front of the building or A-House side.</p> <p><b>End of day pick up</b> will be in the rear of the building ONLY in parking lot 4. <b>Students cannot be picked up at dismissal time in the front of the building, and vehicles cannot park in fire lanes.</b></p>
<p><b>Students Arriving Late To School</b></p>	<p>We have noticed a recent increase in students who are arriving tardy to school over the past few weeks. Please remind your student that punctuality remains important and vital to student performance. We recognize that the mornings are very busy on our campus; however, students and families are asked to plan for any potential delays where possible.</p> <p><b>Thank you in advance for helping us reinforce this expectation!</b></p>
<p><b>IMPORTANT: Student Absence Notification</b></p>	<p>Our families will continue to have the ability to report full day absences, late arrivals and early dismissals via their Infinite Campus Parent Portal using the mobile app or website in place of calling the school attendance line. For specific directions on how to report an absence via the Infinite Campus Portal, <a href="#">click here</a>.</p> <p>As a reminder, families will receive notification of absences on an ongoing basis when students exceed the allowable absence threshold for each of their classes. This notification is aligned to <a href="#">TPS Policy 5113 High School Attendance/Loss of Credit</a>.
