VERBAL INTERVENTION TRAINING COURSE

Verbal Intervention (VI) Training prepares your campus staff to identify, respond to, and prevent low-risk crisis behavior with non-restrictive intervention techniques. The course is delivered in a blended (online and in-person) format.

Course Objectives:

- VI teaches verbal interventions, such as limit-setting, that effectively de-escalate challenging behavior.
- VI explores the effects of trauma and the psychology of the brain on the person in crisis.

NCI training option meets the requirements for campus CPI team training. VI option open to anyone needing verbal de-escalation training without the restrictive methods component. VI training dates coming soon for 2025-26 school year.
