- Landscape of Secondary Mathematics, Deputy Superintendent Mrs. Ondrea Reed
 - During her presentation, Mrs. Reed provided the Board and community with an overview of secondary mathematics in the district. She reviewed the history and impact of the Secondary Math Collaborative (SMC), shared current performance metrics, and highlighted the SMC's ongoing work. The SMC, a self-selective group of secondary math teachers and administrators, is dedicated to improving math education in Los Alamitos USD through collaboration and innovation.
- Development of Board Policy on Student Use of Mobile Communication Devices/Cell Phones Timestamp: 1:45:40 - 2:51:00
 - The Board had a productive discussion regarding the district's cell phone policy and its application across all grade levels. They explored the differences between the needs of TK-8 schools and secondary schools, considering how cell phone use impacts students at various stages of their education. The Board provided clear direction to the Superintendent, who, in collaboration with the Executive Cabinet, will draft a Board policy to be shared with the Board at an upcoming meeting, with a goal of having the policy approved for the upcoming school year.
