Continuing in 2025!

This will be the second year that LMH Health is partnering with the City of Lawrence as a mentor site to offer leadership experience and professional development opportunities.

LMH Health Experience

Those selected can expect to spend time connecting with mentors who can offer guidance, advice, and encouragement in pursuing a career in healthcare and spend time shadowing healthcare executives to observe and participate in their daily routines. Students will be given opportunities to interact with staff and medical professionals while developing and exercising effective communication skills. During this program, students will experience the fast paced and sometimes challenging environment of a hospital and gain valuable insights into the realities of a career in healthcare.

City of Lawrence Experience

Those selected can expect to experience local government management that supports public safety through policy and fire departments, urban zoning and planning, solid waste and water management, public transportation, parks and recreation, and economic development. Students will also gain exposure to executive management of internal services including finance, communications, information technology, human resources, and environmental sustainability.

Selection

- Time Expectation: eight week program, 24 hours/week
- Attendance: Regular attendance is required and critical to the students' success in the Academy
- Age: High School Juniors and Seniors (must be 16 by June 2, 2025)

- Build a more representative and culturally responsive workforce for our community creating a pipeline for students to advance in their future careers
- Provide hands-on experiences
- Expose students to numerous roles within healthcare and city government
- Enhance students' personal and professional skills
