

Licensed Child Care Schedules and The Door

To our Licensed Child Care Families - We understand using the temporary entrance may be throwing off dropoff and pickup times. Even with the temporary entrance, we need families to stick to the schedule they indicated on their 2024 - 2025 **Registration Form & Tuition Agreement**.

Unfortunately, we have families that have been picking up their child(ren) 15 - 30 minutes **LATER** than scheduled, which results in staff working overtime and a negative impact on our building's budget.
