President's Report – Jen D.

Treasurer's Report – Karen F.

- Reviewed the February Treasurer's Report
- New/Continued Inputs - membership, general donations, and post-prom donations (checks from businesses), dining fundraisers (need to add second dining fundraiser amount)
- New Outputs - post-prom deposit

Principal's Report – Mr. Pafk

- Class of 2027 will be the first without class rank, counselors will have access to rank if needed for applications. Survey was shared with the PTO. Obtaining feedback on methods for choosing graduation speakers and for recognition of achievements. Suggestions of allowing for cap decoration and cords at graduation are being considered.
- At the HS students will be able to go into an honors class based on their own interest. Information will be provided to families and students, one of the ways will be through the Gazette. Changes to schedules possible through June 1.
- March 7 Superintendents Day - focus is to get prepared for change

Member asked about very short timeline to provide information for NHS letter of application. Mr. Pafk was asked to allow for an extension.

Member requested that parents and students be informed about how a grade follows a student if changing class level and to have consistency across courses in how this is handled.

Teacher's Report – Ms. Guzzino and Ms. Markarian

- Ms. Guzzino will not be able to join us due to day/time conflict. Welcome to Emily Markarian! Emily introduced herself including that she has been a physical education and health teacher at the MS and HS.

Committee Reports

Instructional Leaders (ILC) – Chris P. & Mr. Pafk

- March and April early release are now full attendance days, March 7 teacher planning day, Reviewed World Languages curriculum proposal
- Transcripts were discussed regarding how courses are listed and items ordered on the transcript, NCAA consideration. Transcripts can be reformatted locally, however a statewide transcript is coming
- Consideration of credit hour increase for graduation to have seniors have meaningful time in school instead of open campus and study halls. May be better to have late arrival/early dismissal instead of open campus.
- Regents review classes after Spring break, discussion of removing common planning period
- Discussion of mid-terms, ½ year courses express a need for mid-terms, teachers use time for planning, exams in class take class instruction time away, if students miss mid-terms teachers need to chase them down for makeups

STAP-COMM – Kelly K.

- No meeting Dec./Jan., new restrictions coming to students for Google on their chromebooks, Panera fundraiser, donut fundraiser, discussion of building, roof, early dismissal into full attendance
