Attention All Drivers!

Unauthorized Parking Will Result in Tickets and Towing!

We understand that parking can sometimes be challenging, but it's crucial to respect designated parking areas. To ensure safety and convenience of everyone we are strictly enforcing parking regulations.

Please be aware that parking in the following designated areas without proper authorization will result in a parking ticket AND your vehicle being towed at your expense. Possible revocation of parking privileges.

- Senior Spots - Painted parking spot and must include OHS parking pass. (Seniors Only)
- Staff Parking - Designated for authorized staff member's only. Clearly marked as STAFF in the parking spot. (Must have New OHS STAFF DECAL)
- Visitor Parking - Reserved for Visitors only. (Clearly marked Visitor)
- Handicap Parking - Must have a handicap placard.
- Other open spots - Must have a current OHS Parking Pass.

Graduating Seniors..

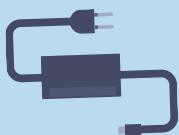
Here is how to purchase your assigned Chromebook (device & charger included):

1. Must have all outstanding fines and fee on file paid.
2. On track to graduate in the school year 2023/2024
3. All devices are sold "as-is" and do not include any warranty or support following the school year's conclusion.
- 4.

All purchased devices will be released from RJUHSD management within five business days of the school year's conclusion. The district will retain ownership of the device until the end of the school year, and all applicable policies will continue to apply.

FAQ

- \$40 - Purchase deadline is May 2nd, 2025 (purchase includes assigned Chromebook and charger)
- What if a student breaks their device after they purchase it? All repair processes, including associated fees, remain the same until the last day of enrollment. If the device cannot be repaired before the end of the school year, an alternative pickup location will be determined. (Technology Services, District Office, Summer School...)
- Can a graduating senior refuse a Chromebook repair? As with our standard policy, student Chromebooks are essential for the curriculum and must be maintained. Repairs are not optional.
- Should a student be allowed to leave with a purchased CB if they have outstanding fines/loaner devices? All fines and fees associated with the student's CB must be paid in full before they can purchase their device.

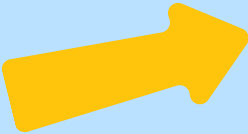
