## **Charleston County School District** **student registration for grades** **Kindergarten through 12th now open**

**Charleston, SC** - Registration for all grades is now open. All students – new and returning – must register and provide residency verification. Access to the registration system can be found [here](#). Completing annual registration for each child is essential as it allows schools to obtain your most up-to-date contact information, including emergency contacts and student medical updates.

Families of currently enrolled students and students who accepted seats through the Choice and transfer processes can register once they receive instructions via email from [noreplyregistration@powerschool.com](mailto:noreplyregistration@powerschool.com). New families can create an account in the enrollment system allowing them to save their progress as they complete the registration.

One exception, Head Start/Early HeadStart and Child Development families will receive qualification letters and registration information at the beginning of June and the beginning of August via email from [noreplyregistration@powerschool.com](mailto:noreplyregistration@powerschool.com).

All students must be registered by the first day of the 2025-2026 school year.

In the event of an emergency impacting your child's school, CCSD will send text messages (called CCSD Alerts) with updates during the event. A summary message (call/email) will occur after the event. To receive these text messages, please provide a phone number identified as a mobile phone in the phone type selection. These forms of communication are sent using the contact information (mobile phone and email) provided through annual student registration. Please note that schools will also use text messaging during the school year for general information.

Registration and proof of residency are required for each child you have in a CCSD school, for both new and returning students in all grades, Early Head Start through 12th grade.

“Annual registration and residency verification is now required to ensure that school officials have up-to-date information on each student,” said Cathleen Milne, Director of Student Information. “The registration software is user-friendly, and the prompts are easy to follow. The registration platform allows families to save their progress and return to complete the registration at their convenience.”
