## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

### WHAT ARE THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS?

Your child must be 3 or 4 years old by the kindergarten eligibility date. In Salem, that is September 10. Families who meet federal income guidelines, are homeless, foster children, families who receive Supplemental Nutrition Assistance (SNAP) or Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF), or Supplemental Social Security Income (SSI) are eligible.

### WHAT IF I DON'T MEET INCOME GUIDELINES?

You are still welcome to apply.

### WHAT IF MY CHILD IS NOT POTTY TRAINED?

That's okay, we will help you to potty train your child.
