Early Childhood



What is ECFE?

Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE) classes are for families with children from birth through Pre-K. Together, families engage in activities and experiences led by licensed staff that nurture children's social, emotional, cognitive, physical, and language skills.



What Happens in an ECFE Class?

Family Time: Families spend time together in a safe classroom filled with developmentally-appropriate learning activities. Part of class time consists of "circle time" where parents, children, and the teacher sing, read, and participate in literacy-rich music and movement activities.

Adult Discussion: Led by a licensed parent educator, parents learn about topics pertaining to child development and share their joys and concerns. (separating classes only)

Children Time: During parent discussion, children engage in child-directed play-based activities facilitated by a licensed teacher. (separating classes only)

Little Learners is our Big Lake Schools preschool program for children ages 3-5. Classes are offered at Liberty Elementary through the Community Education office.



Why Little Learners?

Our incredibly friendly and highly-qualified staff help young students acquire the skills they need to begin their journey as lifelong learners! Our program is thoughtfully aligned with kindergarten by following the Minnesota Early Childhood Indicators of Progress and using research-based curriculums. We offer a well-rounded experience that fosters children's development through outdoor play, engaging stories, music, and movement activities.

Through teacher-directed small and large group activities, we create a nurturing environment that supports each child's growth and learning journey. By focusing on building social-emotional skills, we help preschoolers learn to navigate school and other social environments, setting them up for success in kindergarten!

Also Available: Little Learners Outdoors!

Little Learners with the added benefits of outdoor experiential learning!

Little Learners Outdoors is a preschool program focused on immersive outdoor learning. While our program incorporates both indoor and outdoor learning, most of the class time each day is spent outside. We explore trails, woods and our dynamic nature classrooms, while still incorporating all the key learning curriculum. We use the Minnesota DNR Project Learning Tree and Growing Up Wild curriculums.

Kids Club (K-5)

Kids Club school-age child care program is for children in grades K-5.

We are more than just great child care! We offer a variety of programming, such as arts & crafts, physical education, STEM activities, outdoor games, and more!

Kids Club is open year round from 6am-6pm, Mon-Fri (except major holidays).

Hive Time (Pre-K)

Hive Time is a wrap-around child care option available only for children enrolled in Little Learners Preschool.*

It is considered an extension of the program, as it follows the same philosophies and expands on the learning occurring in the preschool classroom.



Swim Lessons

Seahorse 1 & 2

Parent/Child, Ages 6mo-3 yrs

Parents remain in the water while swimmers work on independently entering/exiting the water, body position, blowing bubbles, & floating. Swimmers gain comfort in the water and develop skills for swimming independently from a parent with the help of a flotation device. **Cost:** \$49

Turtle Level 1

We will focus on water exploration with learning how to float, blow bubbles, push off of the wall, kicking, and small distance forward motion. Swimmers will learn personal water safety along with basic swim competency. **Cost:** \$49

Turtle Level 2

Swimmers will learn to swim and kick longer distances, submerge under the water to pick up a ring from the bottom of the pool, and jump in from the side. **Cost:** \$49

Turtle Level 3

Turtle 3 is for swimmers on the verge of passing into Otter 1, but need a little more practice on specific skills. You must get pre-approval for these classes. **Cost:** \$49

Otter Level 1

Swimmers will be introduced to underwater streamline swimming and kicking longer distances, building on their treading skills, and jumping in from the side and swimming a certain distance. **Cost:** \$53

Otter Level 2 Advanced

Swimmers will explore simultaneous arm and leg motions on their stomach and back. Swimmers will focus on body position, control, and directional change. **Cost:** \$53
