Behavior update: We have some positive news to share regarding our behavior data. Due to the implementation of our strike system, the consistency of our faculty/staff, and our students' hard work, Scott's behavior referrals for the month of October have seen a tremendous decline. In October 2023, 380 behavior referrals were submitted. In October 2024, 97 behavior referrals were submitted. This is something to celebrate. We are also seeing a decline in strikes. September had 904 strikes and October had 630 strikes. We are so proud to see how hard the students are working and adjusting to the expectations in the building.
