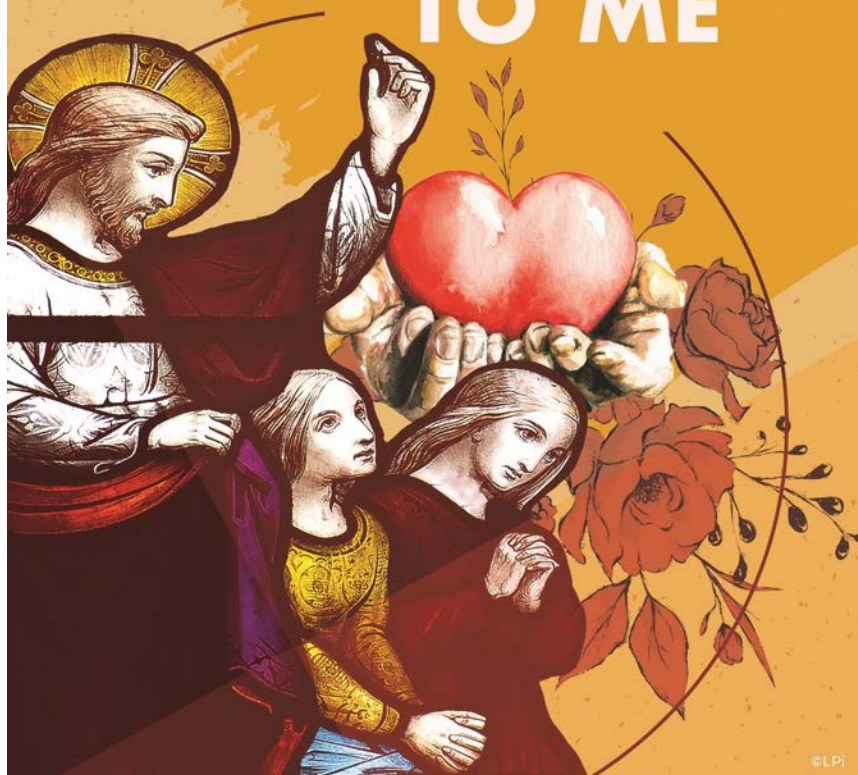

## A Word from Deacon Pat Bruen



This is Deacon Pat Bruen from Boston. I miss all of the good people at Divine Child. I am in my last two months of seminary and am anxious to be back in Michigan permanently. I hope to see you when I'm home over the Easter holiday. I will be ordained a priest on June 7<sup>th</sup> and my first Mass will be June 8<sup>th</sup> at 12:30pm, at Divine Child!

Today I want to talk about suffering and hope – a good Lenten/Easter combination. When we are in the season of Lent, as Catholics we understand that this is leading to the Passion and Resurrection of Christ. We know that Good Friday is coming, but we also know Easter will follow. If we don't feel good about Christ's Passion on Good Friday, we at least know that it is temporary, and we will have Glory (and candy, of course) on Sunday. The suffering of today is tolerable because we have hope for the future.

One of the things the Lord is teaching us in this season is that our lives are very much like Lent and Easter. He wants us to reacquaint ourselves with suffering. We all have burdens. We all have suffering in our lives. But if we live with the hope of Redemption in Christ, we can better know why we suffer. We suffer for the redemption of our souls, for the love of Jesus and if we join our suffering to the Passion of Christ, our hope will grow because we will know the reward.

Jesus is showing us how to suffer. Last week, Fr. John wrote beautifully about the Stations of the Cross. The eighth station, where Jesus speaks to the women, is telling. I would have said, "Yeah, this is bad. Someone help me!" But Jesus only tells them not to weep for him. He is concerned about others in the midst of His suffering. He knows, of course, that He is the hope for the world.

Saint Paul tells us to be joyful in our suffering and to have hope. "Not only that, but we also rejoice in our sufferings because we know that suffering produces perseverance, perseverance produces character, and character, hope." ([Romans 5:3-4](#)) Hope! Hope is one of the three Cardinal virtues: faith, hope and charity. Hope allows us to desire the happiness of Heaven even as we are going through difficult times. Hope gives us the confidence to trust in Jesus, who suffered for us, that we will be with Him in final glory. Every person wants to be happy, and hope gives us that chance to know real happiness in Christ.

Whatever suffering we have brought on ourselves as a Lenten sacrifice, this will help us to grow in holiness and give us a better inherent understanding of hope. So, when we experience pain and hardships in life, great or small, we will not give up. When we say the Divine Mercy chaplet, one of the prayers asks for the ability to "not despair, nor become despondent, but with great confidence, submit ourselves to your holy will." Let us carry on with hope and with great confidence!

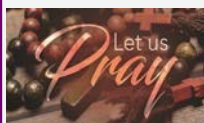
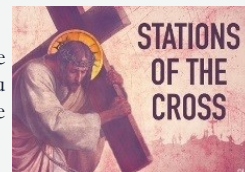

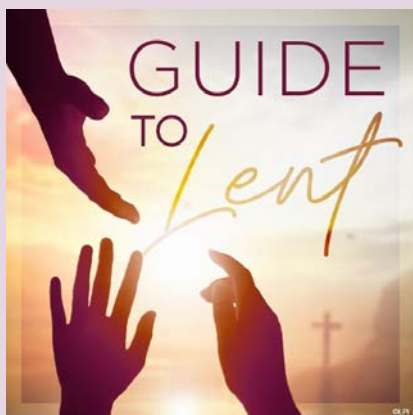

## DC Flashback: Church Bells Installed May 24, 1963

Our bells were donated by the people of St. Casimir's parish in Detroit. They are made of bronze and one weighs four thousand pounds, the other two and the smallest weigh one thousand pounds. In June of 2010, the bells needed repairing. The biggest bell wheel assembly needed to be welded and our Carillon speakers in the tower needed to be replaced. Three of the four had not been functioning for many years.

In April of 2013, we decided to replace the motors and the chains that pull the bells to make them ring. So in May of 2013, we hired experts to come over from Germany to install these new motors and eliminate the chains. The new bell motors were replaced and no longer require chains to make them ring. They are now rung by magnetic motors and DC was the first Church in the United States to have these motors installed by the German company, Rudolf Perner & Co.

Bells have a rich history in the life of the Church, and we are very blessed to have them here at Divine Child. The bells announce that Mass begins in five minutes (which means "hurry if you are not in church yet!"). The bells also toll to announce a funeral or a marriage celebrated. In essence, the bells are a sacramental, meaning they remind us of God's presence.

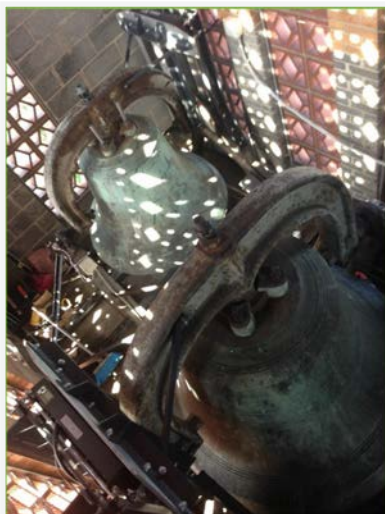


On any given day, a single bell tolls three times prior to noon and 6:00 PM. When the first bell tolls, we are called to stop and recite a particular Scripture passage and then pray a Hail Mary. When the single bell tolls again, we recite the second passage of Scripture and then a Hail Mary. When the bell tolls a third time, we recite the last passage of Scripture followed by a Hail Mary. When we are finished reciting the prayers, all three bells will toll, reminding us of the Good News of Jesus Christ. Collectively, this prayer is called the Angelus. The Angelus, Latin for "angel," is a Christian devotion in memory of the Incarnation (birth of Jesus Christ). The Angelus received its name from the Scripture passage that states, "The angel of the Lord declared unto Mary...."

I hope you will take time to stop and listen when the bells ring and enjoy and appreciate the beauty of the church bells. Our church bells are a blessing and a gift to the parish. (Fr. Jim Bilot bulletin article April 28, 2013)

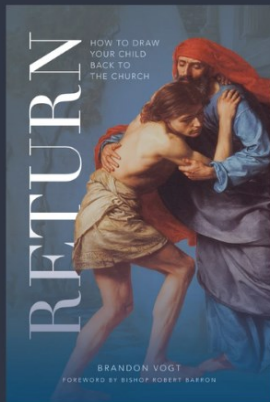

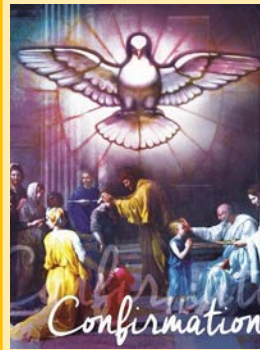

### LAUDATO SI'

Since last school year, DCES students have been involved in living the seven goals of Laudato si', Pope Francis' encyclical concerning care for our planet and care for one another. Students continue to focus on care of the earth, and this year have added another goal, reverencing the dignity of each of us. Some of their brainstorming resulted in continuing the recycling program, collecting rainwater, distributing scarves, gloves and hats to the needy, and writing Christmas notes to veterans, the homebound, and elders in nursing homes. They also have made Christmas wreaths for hospitalized veterans.

This year, emphasis is on students striving to be respectful and kind in their actions and words to all people. In school their actions are rewarded by receiving a kindness coin for each noticeable action of care and respect. Every two weeks the coins accumulated per homeroom are tallied and recognition given, by putting a star on a displayed poster. 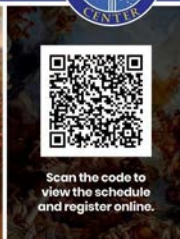
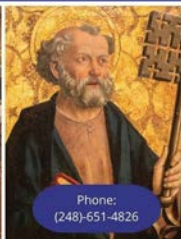

**Right to Life – LIFESPAN IVF is NOT Pro-Life**

In March, we praised President Trump's incredibly significant pro-life policy reforms, but we must also chide President Trump for his February 18 Executive Order titled "Expanding Access to In Vitro Fertilization." The plan calls for "protecting" IVF and subsidizing the (significant) costs of IVF. Using IVF to treat infertility is akin to giving morphine for a broken bone. Sure, morphine will dull the pain, but it will not heal the break. Similarly, IVF bypasses the causes of infertility. IVF does allow many couples to have babies, but it never treats the causes of infertility. There are more effective and ethical fertility treatments (**google NaPro**) which do address the medical issues underlying infertility (i.e. heal the broken bone). We have great love and empathy for those who desire children amidst the cross of infertility and the 12 million children born of IVF since 1978. However, tens of millions of the siblings of those 12 million have been deliberately destroyed or frozen indefinitely in the process. IVF shares the eugenicist mindset behind abortion that a child is a commodity that can be "wanted" or "unwanted" and bought or sold rather than a human being endowed with unalienable rights.

Every first Saturday of the month following the 4:30pm Mass. In emergency situations or after business hours, please call the Rectory Office and listen for the prompts at (313) 277-3110.

### Baptisms

Arrangements must be made in advance and parents must attend a **Baptism class** prior to the Baptism. The Church requires that at least one of the parents and one of the godparents/sponsors be practicing Catholics; that is, they attend Mass each weekend.

### Marriages

One person of the couple must be an active, registered parishioner of Divine Child for at least 6 months. (*Exceptions are made for DC alumni.*) The Church requires a minimum of 6 months for marriage preparation. Potential wedding date is not confirmed until couple meets with a Divine Child priest. All weddings will take place at Divine Child Parish and the celebrant will be one of our priests.

### Funerals

Arrangements are made in conjunction with the funeral home. Eulogies must be given at the funeral home or at the funeral luncheon; no eulogies at the funeral Mass, please. *Memorial Masses* are scheduled Monday-Friday only.

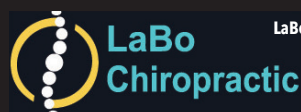
