I loved learning science and anatomy and being able to learn the little things that made the big picture. I have always enjoyed being a caregiver and the more I learned, the more just fueled my passion for healthcare."

After high school, Kate went on to study nursing at the University of Missouri-Columbia (Mizzou) where she would earn her Bachelor of Science in Nursing this past December. Beyond her college clubs that included Best Buddies International, Student Nurses Association, and Operation Smile, Kate graduated with experience and internships that would help prepare her for her current position as a registered nurse at Mercy Hospital- St. Louis.
