Parents and Students of Hillsboro High School,

With the school year flying by, Spring EOC testing is right around the corner. This year, our students will once again be testing in the classrooms. For the high school, we are striving to make testing as least disruptive as possible to the daily schedule and we would like to provide teachers with the maximum amount of time for classroom instruction in preparation for these tests.

To do this, we will once again be testing in 2-hour blocks of time each morning for 7 school days. These dates are listed on the chart below. For these testing days, we will be operating on essentially a "2-hour delay schedule" for any student who <u>IS NOT</u> scheduled to test on each given day. The buses will continue to run on the normal daily schedule, and school will be accessible at the regular morning times. Any student who comes to school and is not scheduled to test will be supervised in a study hall by one of our teachers. For students who <u>ARE TESTING</u>, they will be provided with a list of the tests that they will be required to take, along with the date, and testing location for each of their tests.

Students who ARE testing

-Must report to school by 7:30 -Will report to the assigned testing room -Have regular busing time available -Will be counted absent after 7:30

Students who ARE NOT testing

-Must report to school by 9:30 -Will report to the cafeteria (study hall) -Have regular busing time available -Will be counted absent after 9:30

We understand that this may be somewhat confusing, but we feel that allowing our students their best opportunity to achieve will be worth the short inconvenience. Please contact the high school office at 937-393-3485 if you have any questions or concerns. Thank you for your time and support.
