



Registration Process

- On our school website there are 3 tabs at the top
 - About/Departments/Families and Students
 - RMS website: <u>Rochester Memorial Page</u>
- Go to Families tab on far right and click "New Student Registration" in the drop down menu or Kindergarten Transition Link <u>Kindergarten Transition Link</u>
- This brings you to PowerSchool
 - Powerschool for Old Rochester/RMS
- Proof of Residency-even if you already have a student enrolled at RMS
 - (2 documents)
 - Original Birth Certificate
- Pre-registration is online: Once all paperwork is in, the office will approve the pre-registration
 - An email should go to the parent/guardian (check spam and trash)
 - You will get a specific code and login information in this email (we don't have access to this)

Kindergarten Screening

Dates:

- **Dates:** May 19th (Monday) and May 23rd (Friday)
- **Time Slots**: Families select a 45-minute time slot (5 children per time slot).
- Screening Process: 30-minute readiness screenings and observations for each child.

<u>What to Expect</u>: Students work with a Kindergarten Educator

Why we conduct Kindergarten Screenings:

To see if your child meets expected developmentally appropriate milestones (fine motor, gross motor, academics)

<u>Then What</u>? If a child needs to be rescreened or a possible referral for academic, social-emotional testing. You will be contacted via phone or a letter will be mailed.

A Day in Kindergarten



1st Week for Kindergarten

- First Day of School: Wednesday, August 27th
 - Rescreen any students from June who scored low or had difficulty during the screening.
 - Screen any new students who enrolled over the summer.
 - Inform parents of class placements after screenings are complete.
- Second Day of School: <u>Thursday</u>, August 28th
 - Format: Split Kindergarten cohort students into two groups.
 - Group 1 (Morning): 9:30 AM 11:15 AM
 - Group 2 (Afternoon): 1:00 PM 2:15 PM
 - Parents attend the principal's presentation.
 - Students do not stay—parents will pick up after the session.
 - **Bus Ride Confirmation**: Confirm transportation for Kindergarten students (AM and PM).
 - Confirm Kindergarten students transportation details
- Third Day of School: Friday, August 29th
 - Early release for all students including First day for Kindergarten students.
 - 12:25 Dismissal

Typical Kindergarten Schedule

- 1. Arrival (Breakfast, for some students)
- 2. Classroom (hang up belongings, take out folder)
- 3. Morning Meeting/Circle Time-Calendar
- 4. Reading-Whole Group
 - a. Structured Literacy
 - b. Small Group Instruction/Centers (FLEX Block)
 - c. Model, Practice and Independent Work
- 5. Recess & Lunch
- 6. Specialists
- 7. Math
- 8. Snack Time
- 9. Science/Social Studies












Literacy Work with Into Reading







Skills to Practice for Kindergarten

- Knowing first and last name, practice writing name
- Letter and number recognition
- Counting to 10. Counting Objects with 1:1 correspondence, writing some numbers
- Waiting their turn, sharing, listening
- Express feelings in a calm safe manner
- Using the bathroom appropriately, (we have urinals and stalls)
- Practice using their manners
