• Honors Letter: Full-time students who have a weighted grade point average of 3.5 to 4.0 or above are eligible for this letter.





Fall Academic Consus Day is a day within the Academic Year on which an official count is taken. The Fall Consus Day is the first Wednesday in October. Students identified in 1st - 12th grade in 2021-22 should use the county as of their school attendance on October 6, 2021. Students identified in 1st grade in subsequent years should use the county as of the applicable Fall Academic Census Day.




