- An Academic GPA of a 3.0 is recommended in order to be competitive when applying.
- AP and Honors Courses are highly recommended to be competitive.
- Be involved in Extracurricular Activities (sports, clubs, off-campus organizations, volunteer, etc...)

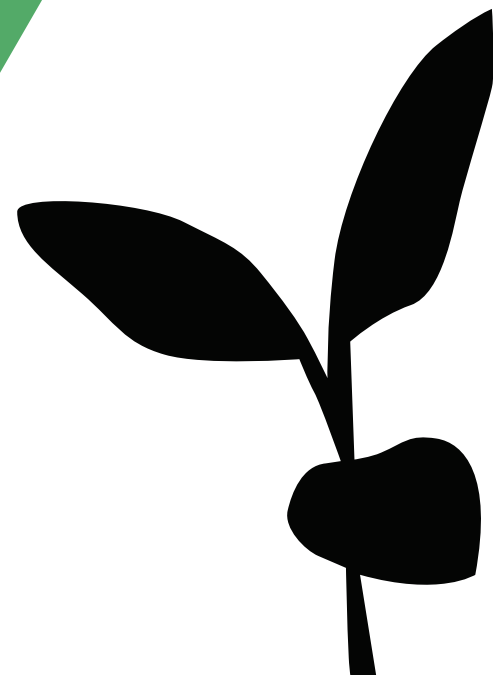

## RHS Academic Awards

### Academic Letters/Chevrons

Academic letters and chevrons are awarded at the end of each semester based upon the following criteria:

- Honors Letter: Full-time students who have a weighted grade point average of 3.5 to 4.0 or above are eligible for this letter.



- White Chevron: Full-time students who have already received their Honors Letter and have earned a weighted GPA of 3.5 to 3.99 are eligible for this chevron.



- Gold Chevron: Full-time students who have already received their Honors Letter and have earned a weighted grade point average of 4.0 or above are eligible for this chevron.



# Other Awards & Recognitions

Have outstanding record throughout their four years of high school in academics, extra-curricular activities & community service. Application submission is required and students will be interviewed and selected by a committee.

## California Scholarship Federation (CSF)

Students identified in 1st grade in subsequent years should use the county as of the applicable Fall Academic Census Day.
