























Improvements at Existing Main Building

Existing Building Modernization Scope Highlights

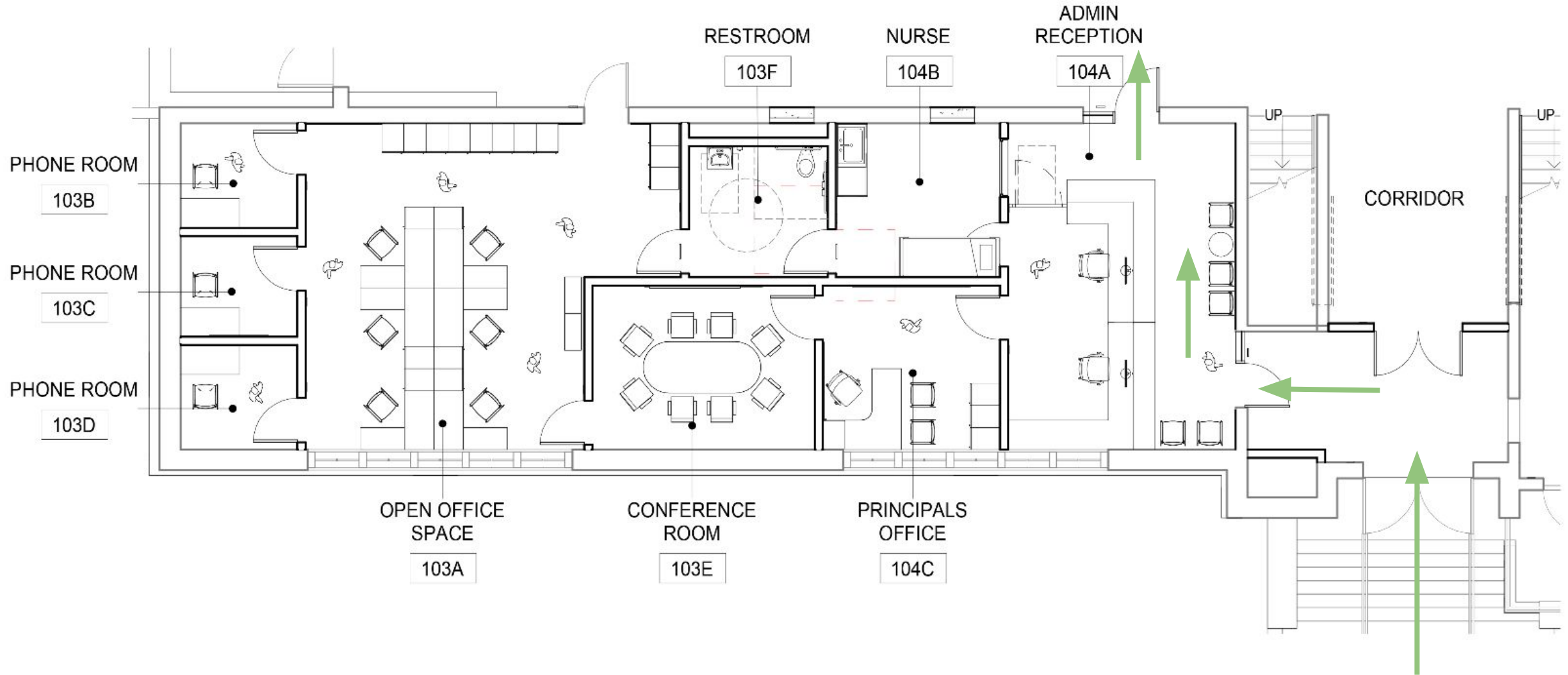
- Installation of electric heat pumps on roof to provide cooling and heating to classrooms to replace boiler and radiators.
- Enlarged admin space with improved entry sequence
- Structural upgrades to building. Involves removal of specific interior or exterior finishes in order to instal reinforcement.
- New fire and intrusion alarm systems
- New plumbing supply lines

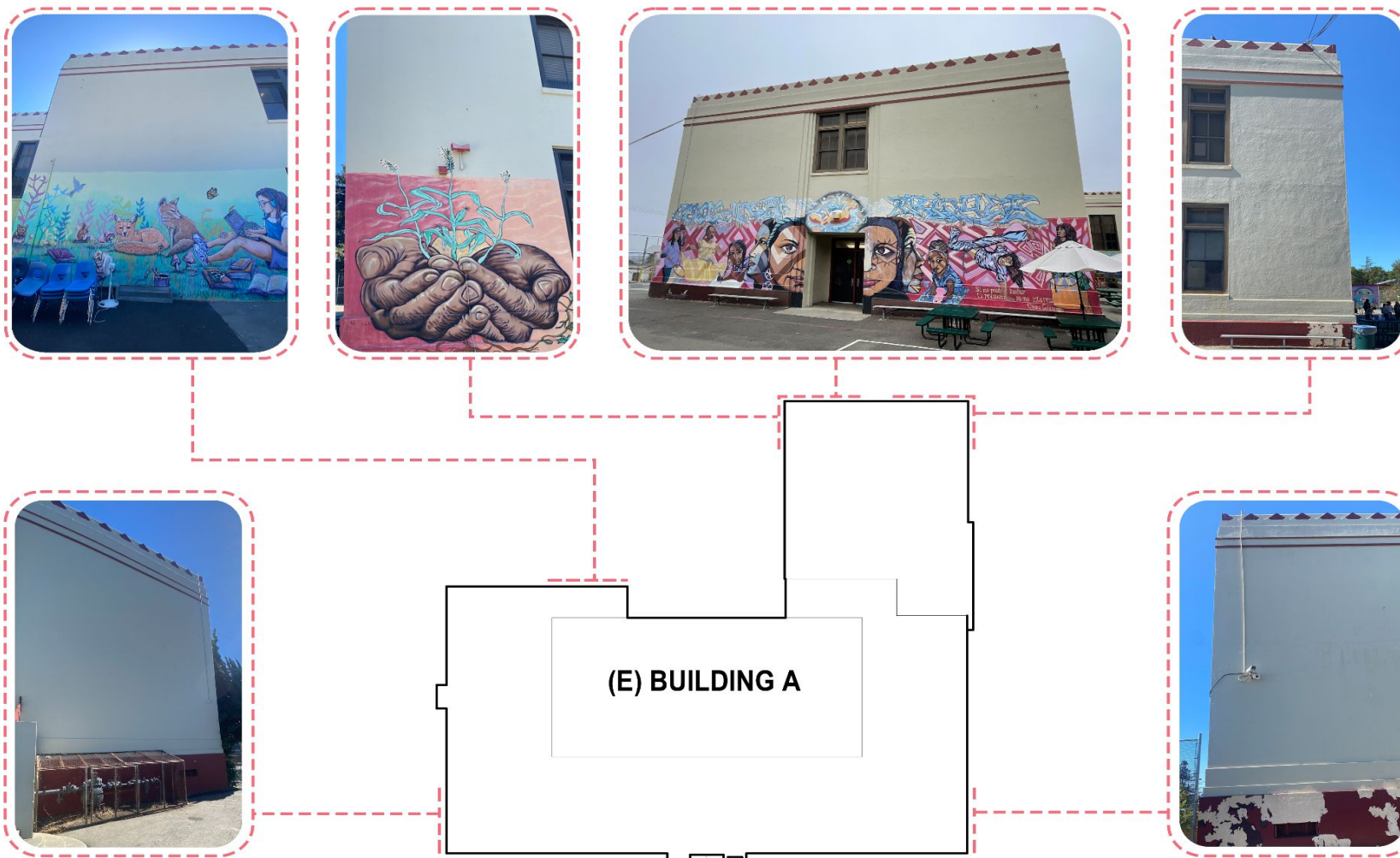

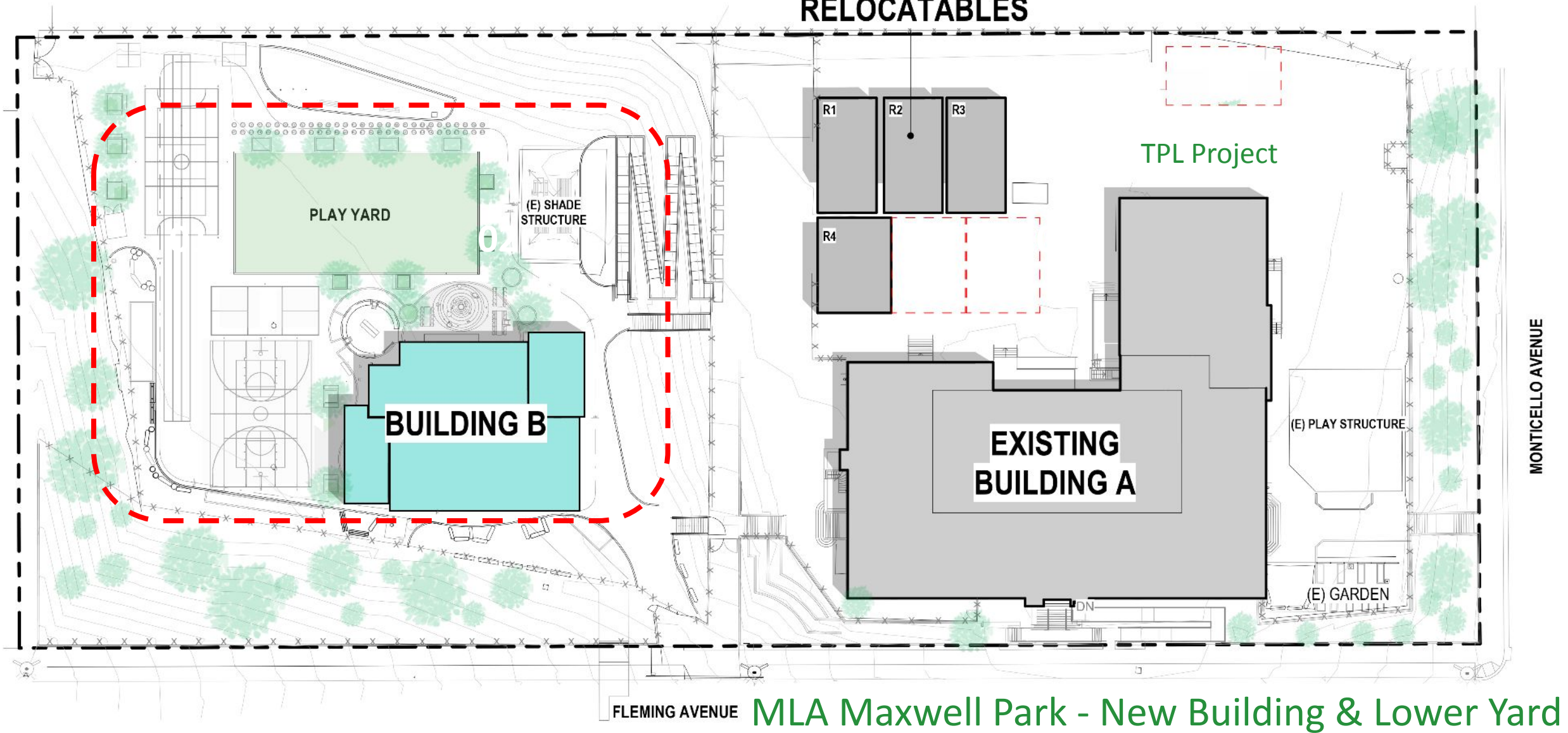


Areas of Shear Wall Improvements and Removal of Existing Murals
