- E. This project consists of replacement of existing plumbing piping systems (underground, in the crawl space, and within the building), replacement of water heating systems, crawl space electrical system repairs and general construction work indicated on drawings and specifications.
- F. Work performed under this contract will be performed under a single prime contract.

#### 1.3 CONSTRUCTION TIMING:

- A. Physical site work is anticipated to begin on June 1, 2024, after the award of the contract and the provision of bonds and insurance, and be partially substantially complete of major systems by July 31, 2024 and shall be fully substantially complete with all systems by December 31, 2024, except as extended by legitimate extensions of time due to unavoidable delays to the project. Major/Minor work is defined as follows:
  - 1. Major Work:
    - a. All kitchen and GYM area work.
    - b. All site utilities that could impact the operation of school facilities during school operations.
    - c. All work that may be acoustically loud that can not be performed after hours or on the weekends.

- 2. Minor Work: All work that can be performed during school hours that do not disrupt school operations and are not acoustically loud. Examples:
  - a. Work in a single restroom or restroom group where students and staff can be directed to other facilities.
  - b. Work pipe supports in the crawl space.
  - c. Insulation work in the crawl space.
  - d. General work.
- B. This Schedule of construction requires the Contractor to provide crews of personnel as required to complete the project on time. Contractor and Subcontractors shall provide sufficient skilled manpower to perform the work.

#### 1.4 PROTECTION OF BUILDING ENVIRONMENT:

- A. Construction activity shall be scheduled in such a manner as to maintain building humidity levels at acceptable levels by allowing HVAC system to operate in a limited capacity.
- B. Contractor shall schedule disabling HVAC systems in work areas as to prevent condensate water from leaking into the crawl space during waste piping system replacements.
- C. Contractor shall install temporary water hoses on certain HVAC roof top units and route hoses to the nearest storm drain to allow some HVAC systems to operate. Schedule a meeting with CISD maintenance to determine the best systems needed to operate in a temporary mode based on the Contractors work schedule. Contractor shall restore all condensate drain piping systems to their original conditions at the end of the project as applicable.

#### 1.5 CONTRACTOR USE OF SITE AND PREMISES AND OWNERS' OCCUPANCY:

- A. Spring 2024 April 1 May 31, 2024 (A-GYM)
  - 1. The Owner shall partially un-occupy the A-GYM general areas; locker rooms, restrooms, showers, office and the like to allow the Contractor to perform some limited work before the start of summer. The A-GYM will be occupied during this time. The contractor may be allowed to work in all areas other than the A-GYM as long as work activities do not disrupt GYM functions.
  - 2. The entire school campus adjacent to the A-GYM will be in use during April 1 May 30, 2024. Contractor shall coordinate their work with the Owner so as to minimize disruption to the functions of district staff and site activities.
  - 3. Testing Dates: Contractor shall perform no construction work during testing days. Contractor shall coordinate all construction activities to avoid work on testing days. Contractor is aware and understands that testing dates are subject to change in duration as required to meet CISD educational and State of Texas requirements. Below is a preliminary look at possible testing activities. Contractor shall coordinate final dates and times with CISD staff after contract award and at the start of construction.
    - a. 04/10/2024: STAAR
    - b. 04/17/2024: STAAR
    - c. 04/18-19/2024: Makeup testing for STAAR
    - d. 04/23-27/2024: STAAR
    - e. 04/30/2024: STAAR
    - f. 05/6-17/2024: AP Testing
    - g. 05/17-21/2024: Senior Semester Testing
- B. Summer 2024 June 1 July 31, 2024:

- 1. The Owner shall not occupy the main high school campus building. Contractor will be allowed to work at the project location unobstructed 24-hours a day, 7-days a week.
- School campus adjacent to construction area will be in partial use during the course of construction for summer activities such as the Field House, Pool, FEMA facility, Industrial Arts, Ag Science, AG Barn, Career Tech and the Science wing and the like. Contractor shall coordinate their work with the Owner so as to minimize disruption to the functions of district staff and site activities.
- C. After July 31 and Before December 31, 2024: Owner will occupy the entire facility
  - 1. School will be in occupied operations generally by Owner during the day from 7:00 a.m. to approximately 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
  - 2. Contractor may work during normal hours or after hours as needed. After hours work at night, holidays, and weekends shall be approved by Owner. The GYMs usually have some weekend actives and at least one night a week there may be activities in the GYMs or the Auditorium.
  - Schedule construction with Owner to minimize interference with Owner regular operations. Cooperate with Owner to minimize conflict and to facilitate Owner's operations. The Contractor shall construct all required temporary appropriate physical barriers to help separate the project work area from the students using school campuses.
  - 4. All active Plumbing, HVAC, and Electrical systems shall remain fully operational at all times during normal business hours unless authorized by Owner.
  - 5. Testing Dates: Contractor shall perform no construction work during testing days. Contractor shall coordinate all construction activities to avoid work on testing days. Contractor is aware and understands that testing dates are subject to change in duration as required to meet CISD educational and State of Texas requirements. Below is a preliminary look at possible testing activities. Contractor shall coordinate final dates and times with CISD staff after contract award and at the start of construction.
    - a. PSAT Testing: Potential Dates October 2, 16, 23 or 30, 2024.
    - b. STAAR Testing: December 3-13, 2024.
    - Some testing will be performed at Quarter, Semester, and MAP in fall 2024.
  - 6. School campus is occupied, the Contractor is responsible for the conduct of their employees and their sub-contractor. Personnel shall conduct themselves in an appropriate manner and within the guidelines and regulations set forth by the Owner.

#### 1.6 SMOKING AND THE USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS:

A. The smoking policy of Calallen I.S.D. is set by state law and applies to all persons involved in the execution of the Work, including deliverymen. This policy, in effect, prohibits smoking and the use of tobacco products anywhere on school property.

#### **PART 1 GENERAL**

#### 1.1 REQUIREMENTS:

- A. The Contractor, Subcontractor, their agents and all others who perform Work on any CISD campuses are required to observe and abide by the campus security.
- B. The Contractor, Subcontractors, and their agents shall comply with the criminal history records checks requirements of Section 13.3 Criminal History Records Checks of the AIA Document A105 2017 Standard Short Form of Agreement Between Owner and Contractor found in Appendix 1 of this RFCSP.
- C. Contractor Superintendent and Designated Support Personal:
  - Shall obtain a permanent Badge issued by CISD and shall also be present at the job site at all times that construction activities are taking place. Superintendent shall be present for all activities. If Owner finds out that the superintendent or their designated staff are not in responsible charge of the construction site, Owner may terminate work activities at the Contractors expense until such time the appropriate personnel are back in responsible charge.
  - 2. Superintendent is responsible for securing the project site each day after work and shall confirm that the site is safe and secure. Check all interior and exterior doors, floor hatches, roof hatches, roof access doors, gates, temporary barricades and the like.
  - 3. Superintendent is responsible for verifying that the project and site are clean after work each day. All trash is disposed of in approved containers. Floor surfaces are clean. Campus grounds are clear and all holes are covered up.

#### D. RAPTOR Checks:

- All contractor personnel shall obtain a RAPTOR check upon their first day of work on the project. The Contractor is required to obtain a replacement badge if their badge gets damaged or becomes non-legible. All personnel will be issued a paper badge with their name, photo, and date of issue. This badge shall be affixed to a badge clip that shall be affixed to their uniform shirt in the upper torso area and shall be worn at all times.
- 2. Contractor shall obtain a new Raptor badge every month around the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month regardless of the initial badge issue date. Contractor shall contact the Maintenance Office and schedule the quantity of personnel requiring retesting in advance so as to not overload the maintenance office regular school activities.
- E. Owner reserves the right to question all Contractor personnel and to perform additional background checks and screening as applicable at their discretions for any persons working on school district property.
- F. All Contractor personnel shall be required to wear company uniforms with company name and logo clearly marked in addition to badges and hard hats with RAPTOR tags that are currently up to date. All attire shall be clean and presentable at the start of work each day.

#### G. Campus Check-in Procedures:

- The project superintendent or designated assistant superintendent shall check in at the main office of each school campus each work day and shall be responsible for facility access and control direct sub-contractor supervision. Contractor personnel and sub-contractors are not required to check-in to a campus that has a Supervisor in responsible charge.
- 2. All employees mush check-in at the Maintenance for the 1<sup>st</sup> day at work and at the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month.

The construction work performed at each campus is directive in nature and work rules for each project can vary depending on the scope of work.
