

BP 935.25 - CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACT REVIEW

Once approved by both the School Board and State Board of Education, the charter school will be subject to a review of its operations and finances by the School District and School Board. There will be a contract between the School Board and the charter school. Contracts will be for a term of five (5) years. If there is evidence of a breach of contract, then the School Board shall have a right to investigate this breach of contract and meet with the charter school to discuss possible remedies.

The approved charter school charter or contract may be amended during the term of the charter (10 years) or contract (five years) at the request of either party by school board action. This includes requests by the academic policy committee for waivers from any provisions of school board policy or administrative regulations.
