The Scholastic Book Fair is coming to our school! This is a great opportunity to connect with your child over the thrill of bringing home new books to dive into again and again.





## **Visible Learning**

As part of the Visible Learning journey at Salina Public Schools, our teachers are focused on being clear in their expectations and instruction to support student learning.

Teachers use learning intentions and success criteria as a way to communicate and help your child understand:

- What am I learning today?
- · Why am I learning this?
- How will I know that I learned it?

Learning becomes more visible for students when there is a connection to what they are expected to learn (learning intentions) and what successful learning looks like (success criteria).

Celebrate learning with your child by asking what they learned this week and how they knew they learned it.

Teachers' use of learning intentions and success criteria combined with families talking about learning - helps grow stronger learners. Your conversations support Cottonwood Elementary's focus on developing our learning dispositions, by reviewing those attributes (thoughtful, co-operative, wonder, resilient) with your child.


