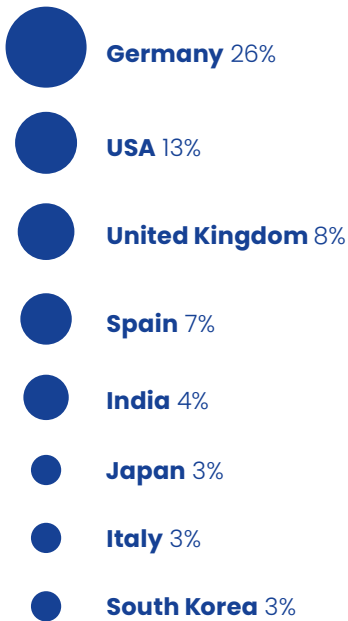
The 1,250 students at BIS come from more than **70 different nations** and speak more than **50 home languages**. They are all united by an international, open mindset.

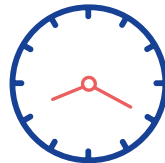
