


#### **NJSLA Combined ELA/Math Scores**



Combined ELA and Math Scores




#### **Overall NJSLA ELA/Math**






#### 2022-24 NJSLA ELA Scores v 2024 New Jersey




#### 2022-24 NJSLA Math Scores v 2024 New Jersey










#### NJSLA ELA/Math - Economically Disadvantaged Learners






#### NJSLA ELA/Math - Students with Disabilities






#### NJSLA ELA/Math - English Language Learners






#### NJSLA ELA/Math - Ethnicity






#### **PSAT Average Scores 2023**






#### **5 Year PSAT Average Scores**








#### SAT at NPHS vs SAT Taken at Outside Venue





#### **ACT Average Scores 2019-2024**







## AP Students with at least one Passing Score vs AP Students Tested






#### Average AP Exam Score: 2020 - 2024





Average score of at least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams







#### **PLTW - Average Scores by Course**

















