## **Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015**

The Keller Independent School District has begun the application process towards participating and maintaining its involvement with the Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015. This federal funding source, also known as the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, provides additional Title I resources to eleven KISD campuses and is based upon a percentage of served economically disadvantaged children: Basswood, Bluebonnet, Caprock, Friendship, Heritage, North Riverside, Parkview, Sunset Valley, and Whitley Road Elementary Schools, Fossil Hill Middle School, and Vista Ridge Middle School currently participate for the 2025-26 school year.

As part of the application process, The United States Department of Education requires the Keller Independent School District to offer federally funded educational services to eligible children attending non-profit private schools in the geographical area served by the Keller Independent School District under the Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015.

The following federally funded programs are addressed in this policy:

Title I, Part A-Improving the Academic Achievement of the Disadvantaged

Title II, Part A-Preparing, Training and Recruiting High Quality Teachers and Principals

Title III, Part A- Language Instruction for Limited English Proficient and Immigrant Students

Title IV, Part A, Student Support and Academic Enrichment (SSAE) Program
