

Laura Kubu Memorial and Stella Schola PTO Senior Scholarship

Dear Stella Schola Alumnus:

We are proud to announce the eighteenth annual Stella Schola PTO Scholarship! The purpose of this scholarship is to provide recognition of the overall academic achievement and community service of a Stella Schola alumnus. This award consists of a one-time monetary scholarship to be used for further education at a vocational, two-year or four-year academic institution.

A minimum \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded by the Stella Schola PTO to one Stella Schola alumnus to be used in the 2025–2026 school year. In the event the recipient has not used the scholarship at a college, university, or vocational school of his/her choice by January 15, 2026, the PTO scholarship will remain in the Stella Schola PTO scholarship fund.

Additionally, Mrs. Laura Kubu, parent of alumni Natalie and Spencer, was a supporter and donor to Stella Schola over a period of seven years. Mrs. Kubu was diagnosed with terminal cancer in 2005 and lost her battle with the disease on May 24, 2008. Her generosity lives on through a memorial fund in the form of an annual scholarship gifted to a graduating Stella Schola alumnus to help pay for college. We admire Laura Kubu for her strength of spirit, for her courage and for her generosity to Stella Schola.

- April 11, 2025 APPLICATION DEADLINE: All applicants must meet the criteria and follow directions on the cover sheet. Applications must be received by Friday, April 11, 2025. Applications will *NOT* be accepted after this date.
- May 1, 2025 Scholarship applicants will be notified by phone or mail around this date.
- May/June 2025 Scholarship may be recognized at the Academic Award Ceremony at the recipient's high school (if available).
