


Family Literacy Activities

APRIL



FLASHCARD GAMES

Create flashcards with letters and pictures of corresponding words.

LETTER SOUNDS BINGO

Play bingo using capital and lowercase letters instead of numbers.

SENSORY BAGS

Fill a bag with materials that can be used to form/build the shapes of letters. Allow your child to use these items to make a particular letter.

PERFUME PLAY

Use different scents to associate with letters (like lavender for "L").



LETTER YOGA

Form letters with body movements or poses.

COMIC STRIPS

Create comic strips using pictures of words that start with a specific letter. Then allow your child to orally tell the story using the pictures as a guide.

LETTER BAKE-OFF

Bake items such as cookies or biscuits in the shape of letters and enjoy sharing and eating them together.

INTERACTIVE WEBSITES

Explore websites with games that teach letter recognition. Type "free games to teach letter recognition" in your browser and many will populate.



WEEKLY LETTER CHALLENGES

Set challenges focusing on a specific letter. Example- For letter "D" have your child "Dry Dishes" or "Dig Dirt."

FIND THE LETTER

Have letter/word scavenger hunts using a book, newspaper, magazine, restaurant menu, or other printed text. The winner is the person who finds the most letters or words.

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
