Taylor Truett Memorial Scholarship

The Taylor Truett Memorial Scholarship is founded in order to honor the memory of Taylor by providing a \$5,000 award to an Aynor High School Senior who will be enrolled in a four-year college or university and who intends to pursue a career in a STEM related field (Science, Technology, Engineering, or Mathematics). The scholarship, moreover, seeks to monetarily support students who demonstrate a robust work ethic in both academics and extracurricular activities.

Scholarship Information

- A one-time, nonrenewable award of \$5,000
- The student must have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA to apply for the award.
- The student may use the award toward the relief of educational-related expenses, such as tuition, books, fees, or room/board.
- The student must be enrolled in an accredited four-year college or university in order to receive the award, which will be disbursed directly to the student.
- The committee will be comprised of Taylor's immediate family who will review the applications. The award will be announced at Aynor High School's annual award ceremony.

Application Instructions

- 500-1000 word essay that describes how the award will enhance and further the advancement of the student's educational and career goals. The student should also use the essay as an informal space to tell the committee about herself or himself and the relevant high school classes and extracurricular activities in which she or he participates.
- Two reference letters from teachers, coaches, community leaders, or pastors
- A transcript that indicates the student's GPA
- A cover letter that lists the student's name and contact information
