Some students are enjoying watching the aquatic life while reading The Giver. “I like looking at the fish,” says Angie Guerra.

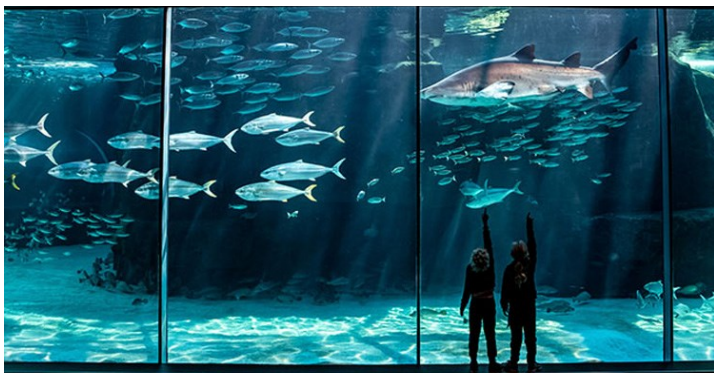
However, not all students are enjoying the experience. “It smells like disgusting fish water,” says Bella Spindler. “It’s distracting.”

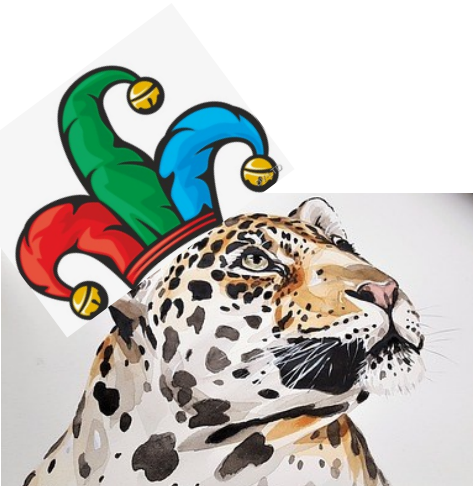
