



WHEN TO KEEP YOUR CHILD HOME



SYMPTOM	DESCRIPTION	SOLUTION
Fever:	Temperature of 100.0 degrees or more.	Student must be fever free for 24 hours, WITHOUT medication, before re-entry. (Texas Administrative Code) <u>Parent note sent to campus attendance for days 1-3. Absences more than 3 consecutive days require a healthcare provider note.</u>
Vomiting:	2 Episodes within a 24hr period.	Student must be symptom free for 24 hours, without medication, before re-entry. (Texas Administrative Code) <u>Parent note sent to campus attendance for days 1-3. Absences more than 3 consecutive days require a healthcare provider note.</u>
Diarrhea:	2 Episodes within a 24hr period.	Student must be symptom free for 24 hours, without medication, before re-entry. (Texas Administrative Code) <u>Parent note sent to campus attendance for days 1-3. Absences more than 3 consecutive days require a healthcare provider note.</u>
Pink Eye:	Red, draining eyes.	Exclude until symptom free, or have a DR's note. <u>DR note sent to campus nurse and campus attendance.</u>
Strep Throat:	Sore throat, Swollen Tonsils, Temperature of 100.0 degrees or more.	Student must be excluded until 24 hours from time antibiotic treatment was begun and fever free 24hrs without medication. <u>DR note provided to nurse and campus attendance.</u>
Common Cold:	Runny nose, congestion, cough, sore throat, head & body aches, temperature of 100.00 or more	Student must be fever free for 24 hours, without medication, before re-entry. (Texas Administrative Code) <u>Parent note sent to campus attendance for days 1-3. Absences more than 3 consecutive days require a healthcare provider note.</u>
Hand, Foot, Mouth:	Temperature of 100.0 degrees or more, Mouth Sores, Rash.	Student must be fever free for 24 hours, without medication, before re-entry. (Texas Administrative Code)
Flu:	Runny nose, congestion, cough, sore throat, head & body aches, fatigue, chills, temperature of 100.00 or more	Student must be fever free for 24 hours, without medication, before re-entry. (Texas Administrative Code) <u>Parent note sent to campus attendance for days 1-3. Absences more than 3 consecutive days require a healthcare provider note.</u>
Covid:	Runny nose, congestion, cough, sore throat, head & body aches, fatigue, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell, temperature of 100.00 or more	Individuals who have COVID-19 like symptoms should follow the Texas DSHS Guidance on COVID-19 Testing. <u>DR Note to Campus Nurse and Campus attendance.</u>
