Curriculum Details



- Teachers are state certified in Early Childhood Education with over a century of combined teaching experience
- Focus will be early literacy, including pre-reading, vocabulary development, letter and number recognition, concept development, patterns, shape identification and the development of social skills
- Formative assessments will be given every nine weeks
