Master Facilities Plan:

Vouchers Hurt Ohio Lawsuit:

- Public school districts have come together to sue the state over the unconstitutional and harmful private school voucher program.
- Money given from Lakota to students for private schooling.
- Lakota is currently #4 in the state of Ohio with vouchers impacting Lakota funding. Lakota has 2,300 students on this program (98% of students are not low-income). This strips millions from Lakota.
