**STARTERS GROUP**  
**AGES 4-5**  
**Pre-K - Kindergarten**



In our Pre-K and Kindergarten Ease into English Summer Camp, young children aged 4 to 5 will engage in English lessons through **fun activities and games**.

Students will participate in a mixture of **outdoor and classroom** activities, aiming to build up their **speaking and communication** skills. Language learning will supplement formal education to make the **upcoming school year** a bit **easier** and September run **smoothly**.

Our environment, with its intensive tuition and **small study groups**, is geared towards helping students develop valuable academic skills that are vital for a **successful transition** into the next grade level. Instruction is delivered by a team of dedicated professionals who bring **unique** experiences and expertise to the field of education. Children should bring a notebook, a pencil case, a refillable water bottle and cold lunch. Additionally, it is important to have a change of clothes in the backpacks.

We want to make the experience of school a **positive** one, developing **good work habits from an early age**. The lessons will be based on different themes, e.g. International Cuisine, Sports and Hobbies, Emotions, Dinosaurs, Vacations, Space and Technology, Archaeology.

# MOVERS GROUP

## AGES 6-8

### 1st - 3rd Grade



Children aged 6 to 8 are invited to engage in **adventures** whilst supporting and expanding their English language skills. Students will engage in daily activities designed to introduce, **develop and improve** their English language proficiency.

Through **experiential learning** experiences, students will develop their **literacy**, information seeking skills, **critical thinking, creativity, digital literacy** and overall language comprehension and proficiency. Their curiosity will be piqued through the **explorations** of fun topics such as Space and Technology, Archeology and International Cuisine.

Our 1st - 3rd Grade program will combine several different elements to allow for a **dynamic learning** experience filled with daily experiential enrichment activities aimed to **immerse them in real-life connections**. Children should bring a notebook, a pencil case, a refillable water bottle and cold lunch.

Areas of focus will include **speaking, listening, writing, researching for information and thematic vocabulary**, presenting, interactive games and conversation through **active hands-on learning** activities that utilize all areas and resources of our school's campus.

**FLYERS GROUP**  
**AGES 9-12**  
**4th - 6th Grade**



Students from 4th to 6th Grade are invited to join in a unique **intercultural** and **transdisciplinary** learning experience to extend and hone their **reading, speaking and listening** comprehension skills, their **digital literacy** and information seeking skills as well as **critical thinking and creativity**.

Students will work in small groups on fun assignments that boost their confidence in using English to **communicate and share** information. Instruction is **interactive and multi-sensory**, teaching both total word construction and phonics.

The **grammatical elements** will be simple tenses (present, past and future), continuous tenses (present, past and future), passive voice and reported speech. The lexical interests are **thematic vocabulary** units (e.g. careers, environmental studies, extreme sports and shopping). Children should bring a notebook, a pencil case, a refillable water bottle and cold lunch.

Students will also be introduced into **academic writing** principles to prepare them for written assignments with proper formality and clarity. The resources include textbooks, online interactive materials and learning through social situations and games.
