The facilities include a purpose-built Kindergarten complex; five computer labs and four science labs; music and recording studios; a drama studio and art gallery; a library and multimedia-equipped classrooms; a multi-purpose sports hall and heated indoor swimming pool; an astroturf football pitch, outdoor courts, and athletics facilities; dedicated spaces for creative and physical activities; as well as a cafeteria, sick bay, and fully climate-controlled environments.
